PROCLAIMING OCTOBER AS  
NATIONAL BULLYING PREVENTION MONTH**

**WHEREAS**, the Oxnard Union High School District supports the rights of students to attend schools that are safe and free from violence, harassment, bullying and discrimination; and

**WHEREAS**, providing a safe school environment that ensures both the physical and emotional safety of the school community creates the conditions necessary to foster academic achievement; and

**WHEREAS**, a safe school is one where teaching and learning are not distracted; disruptions are minimized; drugs, violence, bullying, and fear are not present; students are not discriminated against; expectations for behavior are clearly communicated; early support and positive intervention are provided; and consequences for infractions are consistently and fairly applied; and

**WHEREAS**, bullying is any severe or pervasive physical, verbal or electronic act or conduct, that has or can be reasonably predicted to have a negative effect on any individual or school site; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oxnard Union High School District recognizes that all students deserve to be safe in school, online, and in the community, and that bullying is not acceptable; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that Oxnard Union High School District, does hereby support National Bullying Prevention Month and the proclamation of October 2024 as **National Bullying Prevention Month** in the District, and encourages its students, parents/caregivers, and staff to spread messages of kindness, acceptance, and inclusion.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Oxnard Union High School District supports National Bullying Prevention Month and encourages all staff and students to unite against bullying and share the message that no one deserves to be bullied.
