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| Preliminary In-District Consultation for Goal Setting and Planning This session supports individualized goal setting, strategic planning, equity team support, and guidance in navigating the NYSED CR-SE Implementation Roadmap (K–12). |
| EIB Virtual Leadership Advisory and Networking In these four one-hour interactive sessions, PK–12 district, school, and equity team leaders will collaborate with Nassau BOCES EIB leadership and each other to share insights and strategies that support ongoing efforts to implement NYSED CR-SE practices. |
| EIB Collegial Circle **Virtual** These four, 90-minute facilitated sessions provide a supportive space for superintendents, assistant superintendents, district leaders, school leaders, equity teams, teachers, and school staff to exchange experiences, learn together, and build skills to foster inclusive, equitable learning environments. |
| In-District Customized EIB Support Sessions These sessions are designed to support each district's specific EIB goals. Sessions include, but are not limited to, leadership training, professional development for district/school staff on myriad topics, equity team training and support, engaging stakeholders, and navigating the NYSED CR-SE Implementation Roadmap (K–12). |
| Full School Year Calendar of EIB Workshops Workshops offer in-person and virtual professional learning opportunities, led by Nassau BOCES EIB staff and consultants. The catalog will grow throughout the school year with new and highly requested workshops. |
| Facilitated Book Study Four facilitated book study sessions, led by Nassau BOCES staff/consultants, provide districts with opportunities to engage in meaningful learning from leading experts in EIB. |
