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Dear Tenafly High School Parents and Guardians,

The New Jersey Student Learning Assessments (NJSLA) are comprehensive, computer-based evaluations that assess high school students' proficiency in English Language Arts (ELA), Mathematics, and Science. As required by state regulations, all New Jersey public schools must administer the NJSLA/NJGPA assessments to their students. Below are the testing dates for our high school students.

March 11 – 14: NJGPA Grade 11 ONLY

- 3/11 - 3/12 8:00 A.M. - 2 Days/Units ELA
- 3/13 - 3/14 8:00 A.M. - 2 Days/Units Math

April 29 - 30 & May 1 - 2: NJSLA Grade 9 ONLY

- 4/29-30 8:00 A.M. - 2 Days/Units ELA
- 5/1-2 8:00 A.M. - 2 Days/Units Math

April 29-30: NJSLA Grade 11 ONLY

- 4/29-30 8:00 A.M. - 2 Days/4 Units Science

On testing days, Tenafly High School will follow a condensed bell schedule. Students scheduled for testing should arrive at school by 8:00 A.M. and report directly to their assigned testing rooms. Non-testing students may arrive by 10:30 A.M. for their first class. Additional details will be provided by the building administration.

Students must arrive at school on time by 8:00 A.M. on all test administration days. Late arrivals may require your child to make up a section of the assessment during class time the following week.
