EAGLE ZONE SCHOOL AGE CARE

Eagle Zone (EZ) is a school-based child care program that provides care and education for children before and after school, on non-school days, and during the summer months. The summer program is a full-day program designed to support each child's educational and social emotional development. EZ offers a safe and nurturing environment staffed by educated and experienced professionals. Programs include opportunities for recreation, social skill development and academic enrichment within a supportive and familiar environment.



SUMMER JUNIOR EAGLE ZONE

Summer Junior Eagle Zone is a school-based childcare program designed specifically for students entering kindergarten in the fall. The program is designed in a way that meets the needs of our Junior Eagles, knowing that they have not yet started their elementary education journey. This includes age-appropriate field trips and an onsite curriculum.



EPIC CAMPS & COURSES (K-8 YOUTH ENRICHMENT)

Youth enrichment provides children with educational programs and activities that extend beyond their regular school day. Enrichment programs are designed to address youth needs in many areas such as academic, cultural, social, emotional, and recreational. The program boasts a wide range of offerings, including technology, art, music, languages, math, reading, science, sports/recreation, and more. Enrichment classes provide students the opportunity to improve academic and social skills, explore new interests, gain new skills, and make new friends.

Registration Options: Eagle Zone provides flexible summer registration options to accommodate your student’s needs. Review the options below to choose the best fit for your student this summer. It’s important to note that each student may only have one summer contract per student at a single location throughout the season, and families won’t be able to switch between sites at any point during the summer.



Oak Point/Eagle Heights Elementary

This summer at Oak Point/Eagle Heights Elementary, Eagle Zone is available for students who need full-day care only. Each grade group will enjoy tailored activities and trips designed for their specific

age group. *Please ensure that you register your students for the grade group they will be entering in the Fall of 2025.*

FULL DAY:

- **Junior Eagle Zone:** Junior Eagle Zone is designed for students entering kindergarten in the fall of 2025.
- **1st-2nd Grade:** Incoming first through second-grade students in the fall of 2025.
- **3rd-5th Grade:** Incoming third through fifth-grade students in the fall of 2025.



Eden Lake Elementary:

This summer at Eden Lake Elementary, students attending Targeted Services or Extended School Year (ESY) and their siblings will have the opportunity to participate in Eagle Zone designed

to meet the needs of families participating in both programs.

Although registration won’t be divided by grades, our on-site staff will tailor the programming to address all attending grades effectively.

FULL DAY:

Students enrolled in Targeted Services or Extended School Year and their siblings are welcome to enroll for days when care is needed for a full day.

HALF DAY:

Students enrolled in Targeted Services or Extended School Year at Eden Lake may participate in half-day Eagle the coinciding weeks that they are enrolled in classes. Half-days are a weekly option, students must have a consistent schedule during the weeks that they are enrolled in the half-day Eagle Zone.

All registration options require a 14-day schedule change notice. Any days within that will be considered drop-in care and are not guaranteed. Half-days do not have a drop-in option.



Registration Dates & Fees

Registration opens online on **Monday, February 17 at 8:00 a.m.** at edenprairie.ce.eleyo.com. Registration acceptance will be on a first-come, first-served basis beginning March 2025.

A one-time registration fee is charged on the following scale:

- February 17–March 17: Fee waived
- March 18–August 7: \$50/child non-refundable fee
Maximum of \$100 per family

Program Cost & Fees

DAILY RATES:

Full-Day (OP/EHSI and Eden Lake):

\$55/child per day (\$64 drop-in rate)

Drop-in is considered if the day of care is requested within 14 calendar days of when the care is needed.

Half-Day (Eden Lake only): \$135/child per week, Monday–Thursday

Student must be enrolled in a Targeted Services or Extended School Year class the same week.

ADDITIONAL FEES:

Late pick-up fees will apply to the families' account at \$1 per minute/per child, after 6:00 p.m.

Late payment fee \$15

What time does Eagle Zone start and end?

Full-day Eagle Zone opens at 7 a.m. and closes at 6 p.m. at both locations. Half-day Eagle Zone begins at noon and ends at 6 p.m. at Eden Lake.

FAQS: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is new this year?

Eagle Zone will not coincide with EPIC programming this summer, and transportation will not be available between an EPIC site and Eagle Zone. If your child is interested in EPIC and requires a full day of activities, please register for both morning and afternoon sessions during the weeks they plan to attend an EPIC course.

Summer Eagle Zone is available for incoming K–5th grade students. Unlike previous years, it will not be offered for incoming 6th-grade students.

Please note: Each student is limited to one summer contract at a single location for the entire season. Families will not be able to switch between sites at any time during the summer.

Which site should I register my student for this summer?

What field trips or activities will be offered?

- Full-day care at Oak Point/Eagle Heights will include field trips two days per week. Dates will be available in the coming months.
- Full-day and Half-day care at Eden Lake will have onsite field trips on Tuesdays when classes are in session and offsite on Fridays.
- Off-site field trips include activities such as swimming pools, parks, mini golf, local zoos, and many more!

- On-site field trips include activities such as bounce houses, magicians, animal visitors, and more.
- All field trip costs are included in the daily rate. There may be days when you will have the option to send additional money with your child for things such as spending money on offsite trips. These will be advised by sites before events and will always be optional.
- Days when field trips are off-site, please be sure to have your child at Eagle Zone before busses leave and plan to pick up after busses return to site.

On days without scheduled field trips, we have a range of age-specific activities planned, both indoors and outdoors. These activities encompass various engaging experiences, including arts and crafts, science experiments, outdoor play, gym time, cooking activities, and more!

Stay tuned for detailed field trip information, which will be provided in the coming months to families registered for programming. Our dedicated team is diligently planning trips to cater to the diverse needs of all our students!

Are there financial assistance options for summer?

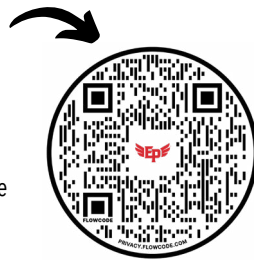
Eagle Zone is certified with many Minnesota counties to receive childcare assistance. We also work with Childcare Aware for active military families. Please contact us for more information on programs we utilize for childcare assistance.



Frequently Asked Questions cont.

How do I create a contract?

Each new season (school year and summer) families must create a new contract for each student. Create or go into your Eleyo account, and register for the session you want by clicking on enroll now. Scan the QR code below for more information on how to create a contract.



How will contracts be accepted?

Enrollment in Eagle Zone for Summer 2025 operates on a first-come, first-served basis. To secure your spot, we encourage you to register promptly, providing all your summer scheduled dates for all 10 weeks of summer. Schedule changes will only be accepted based on staffing availability at each site.

Contracts will begin to be accepted in March of 2025. You will receive an email with your acceptance from Eleyo once your contract has been approved.

Can I change my schedule?

Yes! All changes must be made outside of a 14-day calendar notice from the day you are looking to change. Contract changes can only be made after the contract has been accepted. You will go into your Eagle Zone account in Eleyo, click on your current and upcoming Eagle Zone contract, and then click on change schedule. There may be a limited availability for drop-ins at each site throughout the summer. These will all be approved based on day-to-day site availability to keep our student-to-staff numbers at a 15:1 ratio as required by the Minnesota Department of Human Services (DHS).

Why do I have to give a 14-day notice to change my schedule?

We schedule our staff two weeks in advance to keep our staff-to-child ratios in compliance with the Department of Human Services (DHS). As a certified childcare program, DHS requires a 15:1, student-to-staff ratio. If your child(ren) does not attend a day that was scheduled, we still have to maintain our staff and planned activities for that day.

How will I be billed?

We post-bill. For example, families will be billed in July for contracted days in June. This allows us to maintain the flexibility of scheduling for families. The invoice for June will be sent out in the first week of July. The payment for this invoice will be taken out automatically with the EZautopay on the 15th of the month. If families want to pay a portion or all of the bill before the 15th, they can go into their account and make a payment, any remaining balance will be taken out on the 15th. If, for any reason, the EZautopay form of payment (expired card, lost card etc..) does not work, a \$20 fee will be applied to the account. Families will be notified and have a grace period of five days to remedy the payment

method and manually pay the balance. After the grace period, a late payment fee of \$15 is applied.

Is there transportation available?

There is no transportation available to and from Eagle Zone. An authorized person must drop off and pick up all students and provide a signature.

Does my student need to bring lunch or snacks?

All students need to bring their cold lunch. There will be no refrigeration or ability to heat any lunches. Snacks will be provided in the morning and the afternoon for all students. If your student has a specific food need, you are welcome to provide your own snacks.

Why is Eagle Zone not available for EPIC students?

Both EPIC and Eagle Zone are committed to meeting the needs of our Eden Prairie families. Due to the growing demand for EPIC, we have relocated EPIC and Eagle Zone to separate buildings to maximize opportunities for both programs. This allows us to offer more classes in EPIC and ample space in Eagle Zone to best meet each student's needs and interests.

We understand this adjustment may be inconvenient for some families; however, Eagle Zone's half-day option is only available to students attending educational support programs over the summer. Families seeking full-day programming have a choice of enrolling in morning and afternoon EPIC sessions or full-day Eagle Zone for a fun and engaging summer experience!

What if I am not sure whether my student will be in Extended School Year (ESY) or Targeted Services (TS) this summer?

If you think your child might participate in Targeted Services or ESY, please register them at Eden Lake Elementary. If your student ends up not being referred for ESY or Targeted Services, we will transfer your student's child care registration to Oak Point/Eagle Heights. The switch must be made before June 1st.

Can I still register for Eden Lake Eagle Zone if I think my student will be in Targeted Services (TS) or Extended School Year (ESY) but I am unsure which section they will be in?

Yes. Once your TS or ESY referral is confirmed, your Eagle Zone Child Care contract will be approved at Eden Lake. Once the contract is approved, you will be able to modify your contract to correlate the correct session that your student is attending (half-days or full days).



Where should I register for Eagle Zone?

We know that figuring out your family's summer schedule can be complicated! Unsure which to select? Take out the guesswork by following the flow chart below!

It is up to each family if you would like your sibling who is not participating in Targeted Services or Extended School Year to go to Eden Lake or Oak Point/Eagle Heights. We do encourage any student who is not participating in TS or ESY to attend Oak Point/Eagle Heights full days.

Oak Point/Eagle Heights Summer Eagle Zone is designed programming for each specific grade group where Eden Lake Eagle Zone won't be divided by grades, but our on-site staff will tailor the programming to effectively address the needs of all students attending

NEW this summer: All incoming 6th graders must participate in EPIC camps at Central Middle School.

6th-8th grade:

EPIC camps & courses are held at Central Middle School for all incoming 6th-8th grade students.

Dates & Times

EPIC Camps & Courses:

There are eight weeks of EPIC programming, which take place Monday–Thursday from June 16 through August 14. *(There is no programming the week of June 30–July 4):*

- Week 2: June 23–26
- Week 3: July 7–10
- Week 4: July 14–17
- Week 5: July 21–24
- Week 6: July 28–31

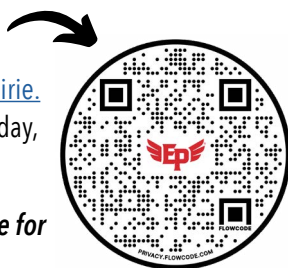

EPIC classes take place in the morning from 9:00 a.m.–12 p.m. and in the afternoon from 1–4:00 p.m. CMS Field Trip times vary.

Registration

To attend an EPIC course, you must create an account and register online at edenprairie.ce.eleyo.com. Registration opens on Monday, February 17, 2025 at 8 a.m.

Register your child based on their grade for the 2025-26 school year.



Meals & Snacks

Students attending both a morning and an afternoon class should bring a non-refrigerated lunch and a non-refrigerated beverage.

Students attending only a morning or only an afternoon class should bring a peanut-free snack.

All students should bring a water bottle labeled with student's name.

Program Costs

EPIC camps & courses are fee-based courses that vary in price, generally between \$109-\$225 per class. The rate varies based on the cost of operating the course, including working with third-party vendors in specific classes.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up Process

We will utilize the curb-side drop-off and pick-up process for all EPIC students. A staff member will support your student and direct them to and from the car.

- Morning Session Drop-Off: 8:45–9:00 a.m.
- Morning Session Pick-Up: 12–12:30 p.m.
- Afternoon Session Drop-Off: 12:45–1:00 p.m.
- Afternoon Session Pick-Up: 4–4:30 p.m.

More detailed information on where to drop off and pick up your student(s) will be shared closer to the start of summer programming.

Cancellation & Refund Policy

Any cancellation to an EPIC class or registration modification MUST be emailed to EPIC@edenpr.org. Full refunds will only be made up to 7 calendar days before the class begins. Refund requests made within 7 calendar days of the class start date or after the class has started will not be eligible for a refund. **There is a processing fee of \$10 for any EPIC registration cancellation. However, if your child's registration is canceled due to enrollment in Targeted Services, the \$10 cancellation fee will be waived.**

To transfer your student's registration to a different class, please email us at EPIC@edenpr.org. We'll be happy to assist you with the change.

If your student(s) is absent from class, you will not be refunded for missing that day of class. Please notify us at EPIC@edenpr.org if your student is going to be absent.

FAQS: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is new this year?

EPIC will not coincide with Eagle Zone this summer, and transportation will not be available. *If your child is interested in EPIC and requires a full day of activities, please register for both morning and afternoon sessions.*

Summer EPIC is available for incoming K-5th grade students at Prairie View Elementary.

Incoming 6th-8th graders must attend EPIC at Central Middle School.

When does registration for Summer EPIC open?

Summer 2025 registration for EPIC camps & courses opens on Monday, February 17 at 8 a.m.

Does my student need to bring lunch?

If your student is enrolled in a morning course and an afternoon course, there is a supervised lunch break for students from 12-1 p.m. Families must provide lunch and drinks for their students during this time.

Where will we drop off/pick up our child(ren)?

We will continue to use curbside drop-off and pick-up this summer. When dropping off, we ask that you remain in your vehicle and your student exits the vehicle CURBSIDE ONLY. A staff person will direct your child into the building. This allows for the movement of traffic through the drop-off carpool lane.

For pick-up, we will ask for your student's name when you pull up to the designated pick-up zone. We will escort your student into your vehicle on the curbside.

More information on designated drop-off/pick-up times will be released closer to the first day of summer programming.

Is there busing provided to EPIC camps & courses?

Is there busing provided from site-to-site?

No. You are responsible for dropping your student(s) off and picking them up from Summer EPIC. We do not offer transportation from site to site or from the school to/from home.

How are kids supervised during the drop-off and pick-up time?

Program staff will supervise drop-off and pick-up times outside the regular course times.

If my child attends EPIC Monday–Thursday and needs childcare on Fridays who can I call?

If your child is an incoming Kindergarten through 5th grade, you have the option to sign up for Eagle Zone School Age Care on Fridays. Please contact Eagle Zone - School Age Care Specialist, Denise Weber at 952-975-6953 or Eagle_Zone@edenpr.org.

If your child is an incoming 6th through 8th grader, we do have Friday Field Trip options available at CMS.

What if my child is not referred for Targeted Services – can they still attend EPIC summer courses?

Yes! We offer a wide variety of EPIC summer courses, and our goal is to provide classes that are accessible in a way that offers an opportunity for each student.

How will check-in and check-out work?

We'll use curbside drop-off and pick-up this summer. When dropping off, we ask that you remain in your vehicle and your student exits the vehicle CURBSIDE ONLY. A staff person will direct your child into the building. This allows for the movement of traffic through the drop-off carpool lane. For pick-up, we'll ask for your student's name when you pull up to the designated pick-up zone. We will escort your student into your vehicle on the curbside.

What happens if I am late picking up my child?

Pick-up times must be followed each day:

- EPIC morning session ends at 12 p.m., with pick-up required by 12:30 p.m.
- EPIC afternoon session ends at 4 p.m., with pick-up required by 4:30 p.m.

Any student picked up late is subject to a late pick-up fee of \$15 per late pick-up.

What impact would the weather have on EPIC?

All courses have rain backup plans to ensure we can run each course as scheduled. In the event of severe weather, communication would be shared with families regarding the status of the courses for that day.

When do I pay for my student(s) EPIC course?

Payment for any EPIC course is required at the time of registration. Once you complete the enrollment questions, the system will add the course into your cart. Registration will be complete when you check out and process payment.

My student is signed up for a morning EPIC course. Can they go to half-day Eagle Zone in the afternoon?

No. Half-day Eagle Zone is only available for students in Targeted Services and Extended School Year.

What should my student(s) bring each day to EPIC?

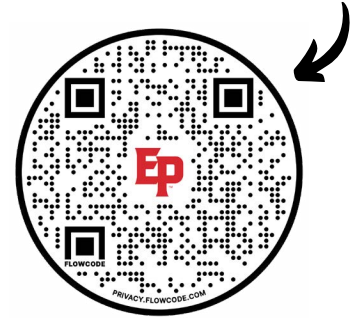

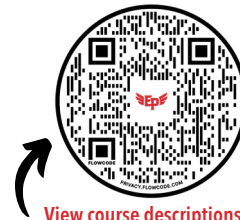

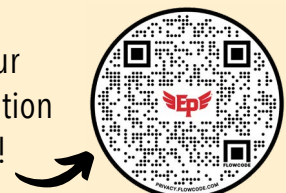

TARGETED SERVICES

ELEMENTARY: INCOMING 1ST-5TH GRADE

WHAT IS IT?

Targeted Services is Eden Prairie Schools summer learning program. This state-funded program provides students with a valuable opportunity to enhance their literacy, math, and social-emotional skills through select courses—offered at no cost to families—as part of our Summer Youth Programs. Targeted Services classes are taught by licensed teachers and align with district academic standards. **Students must meet certain academic criteria to participate in Targeted Services and will be recommended by their teacher.** While participation is optional, we strongly encourage students to attend!

Targeted Services for Summer 2025 will look different than in past years for the elementary students. We are offering two 3-week sections. Students may qualify for one or both sections. Parents/guardians will not need to register their student(s) for Summer Targeted Services – students will be enrolled in the section that best meets their academic needs. You will receive information in late March/early April with information regarding which section of Targeted Services your child is registered for, as well as information regarding (optional) transportation.

Your student’s teacher and school’s Targeted Services team will connect with you once referral qualifications are made to let you know next steps for Summer Targeted Services. Please expect to hear from your student’s teacher and/or school Targeted Services team in March/early April.

NEW THIS YEAR:

- ALL incoming 6th grade students (school year 2025-26) MUST attend Targeted Services at Central Middle School.
- Parents/Guardians WILL NOT register their student(s) for Targeted Services on their own. Student’s will be registered in late March or early April with their schools Targeted Services team.
- Siblings of students who are referred for Targeted Services CANNOT ride the bus with their Targeted Services sibling for Eagle Zone Child Care or EPIC camps and classes.

WHEN/WHERE IS IT?

Summer Targeted Services will be held at Eden Lake Elementary for incoming 1st-5th grade students. Targeted Services will be offered Monday, July 7 to Thursday, August 14. Each section will run Monday-Thursday 8 a.m.–12 p.m. each week.

- Section 1: Monday-Thursday, July 7-24**
- Section 2: Monday- Thursday, July 28-August 14**

**Reminder, your student(s) will only attend ONE section of Targeted Services based on their academic need.*

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION?

Students referred to Targeted Services who live in the district boundary can sign up for free bus transportation to and from Eden Lake Elementary. We will be reaching out to all families whose students qualify for Targeted Services in late March/early April to inquire if transportation is needed.

WHAT IS IT?

Targeted Services is Eden Prairie Schools summer learning program. Your student's teacher and the school's Targeted Services team will connect with you once referral qualifications are made to let you know of the next steps for Summer Targeted Services. Please expect to hear from your student's teacher and/or Targeted Services team in late March/early April.

NEW THIS YEAR:

- ALL incoming 6th-grade students must attend Targeted Services at Central Middle School.
- Parents/Guardians WILL NOT register their student(s) for Targeted Services on their own. Student's will be registered in late March or early April with their schools Targeted Services team.
- Siblings of students who are referred for Targeted Services CANNOT ride the bus with their Targeted Services sibling for an EPIC camp or class.

WHEN/WHERE IS IT?

Summer Targeted Services will be held at Central Middle School for incoming 6th through 8th grade students. Targeted Services is offered as one 6-week section from Monday, July 7 to Thursday, August 14. Each week will run Monday-Thursday, 9:30 a.m.–12:30 p.m.

IS THERE TRANSPORTATION?

Students referred to Targeted Services who live in the district boundary can sign up for free bus transportation to and from Central Middle School. We will be reaching out to all families whose students qualify for Targeted Services in late March/early April to inquire if transportation is needed.

The week before summer begins, you will hear directly from our Transportation Department with your student's bus stop, pick-up and drop-off times. Please direct any questions about busing to Transportation, at 952-975-7500.

FAQS: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I know if my student qualifies for Targeted Services?

All placement decisions are determined by your student's teacher and Targeted Services Team. Please expect to hear about your student's Targeted Services referral from your school in March or April. If you have questions about Targeted Services placement, please connect with your student's classroom teacher.

Do I register my student for Summer Targeted Services?

No, parents/guardians DO NOT need to register their student for Targeted Services on their own. You will receive information in late March/early April regarding which section of Targeted Services your child is registered for, as well as information regarding (optional) transportation.

Does my student need to attend the full session?

We recommend that all students who qualify for Targeted Services attend the full, 3-week session for Elementary age and the full 6-week session for Middle School age. This will provide the most educational benefit and opportunity for skill growth.

Is food provided during the summer?

No - we do not have Child Nutrition staff on-site during the summer, so we do not provide any snacks or meals. Please plan to send your student with a snack and water bottle each day (and a lunch if they are signed up for a full day of programming).

Can I cancel my student's summer Targeted Services if our plans change?

Yes. We will have a process in place for how to cancel your student's Targeted Services section.

What should my student bring to Targeted Services?

Students must bring: clothing and shoes that can be worn outside; a water bottle labeled with student's name; and a peanut-free snack. We also recommend applying sunscreen, as each group takes a break outside. All other materials will be provided.

Is there a cost for my student to attend Targeted Services?

There is no cost to attend the morning Targeted Services courses for students who qualify for Targeted Services. All students are welcome to register for afternoon EPIC courses as well, which range in cost based on the course.

My student receives Special Education services during the regular school day. Is there support in place for them?

If your student qualifies for Targeted Services, classroom support will be provided.

What is the difference between Targeted Services and Extended School Year?

Targeted Services is an academic referral-based program designed to strengthen student's literacy and/or math skills. If you are unsure if your student was referred, please contact their teacher.

Extended School Year (ESY) is specialized programming for some students with IEPs who qualify for additional services during the summer. If a student qualifies for ESY services, these services would be listed on a student's IEP. If you have questions, please contact your student's special education case manager.

Is Transportation available?

Students who qualify for Targeted Services are eligible for free bus transportation to and from morning Targeted Services courses. More details on summer transportation will be sent to families in the Spring.

Can a sibling not in a Targeted Services class take the bus to/from the school?

No. Siblings of students referred for Targeted Services are not allowed to ride the bus to/from school for Eagle Zone child care, elementary EPIC at Prairie View, or Central Middle School EPIC.

Elementary EPIC takes place at a different location than Targeted Services, and parents/guardians must drop off and pick up their students directly from EPIC.

Eagle Zone child care requires a parent or guardian's signature for check-in and check-out, except for students arriving from a Targeted Services class at noon. Siblings of students in Targeted Services must always be dropped off and picked up by a parent or guardian.

When do I pick-up and drop-off?

If your child isn't riding the bus, they need to be dropped off and picked up every day by a parent/guardian at Eden Lake Elementary or Central Middle School.

Elementary Targeted Services

- Morning Drop-Off: 7:30-8 a.m.
- Afternoon Session Pick-Up: 12-12:30 p.m.

Middle School Targeted Services

- Morning Drop-Off: 9-9:30 a.m.
- Afternoon Session Pick-Up: 12:30-1 p.m.

If my child is not referred for Targeted Services, what options for summer programming do I have?

All students, incoming 1st-8th grade, are welcome to attend EPIC camps and classes. Incoming kindergarten through 5th grade are eligible to attend Eagle Zone Child Care.

We have a variety of EPIC camps and courses at Prairie View Elementary and Central Middle School for students in the morning and afternoon. There is a fee attached to each camp, but we offer scholarships to families who qualify.

Eagle Zone child care is open for incoming kindergarten through 5th grade students, Monday through Friday if you are looking for a child care option.

What fee assistance or scholarship opportunities are available for afternoon EPIC summer camps and classes?

Why can't I pick my students' Targeted Services class?

Students will be placed in summer classes based on their needs in reading, math, or social-emotional skills. These needs are determined by classroom data and teacher input.

My student does not go to Eden Prairie Schools. Can they still qualify for Summer Targeted Services?

No. Summer Targeted Services is only available to current Eden Prairie School students.
