

**Fever:**

**STAY HOME:** If temperature is 100.4 or higher.

**RETURN WHEN:** fever went away overnight and is gone the next morning without the use of medications such as Tylenol, Motrin, Advil (ibuprofen or acetaminophen).

**Antibiotics:** May return if taking antibiotic for at least 12 hours. Follow **FEVER** protocol above.

**Vomiting:**

**STAY HOME:** if student has vomited two or more times in a 24-hour period.

**RETURN WHEN:** vomiting had ended overnight and able to hold down food and liquids. Recommend frequent handwashing.

For vomiting with fever, also follow guidance for **FEVER**.

**Diarrhea:** **STAY HOME:** If student is unlikely to make it to the toilet in time. Follow **FEVER** guidance.

**SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION:** If stool looks bloody or black.

**RETURN WHEN:** improving. Recommend handwashing.

**Cold Symptoms: Cough, Runny Nose/Congestion or Sneeze:** Mild symptoms-student is ok to attend school.

**STAY HOME AND SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION:** for severe symptoms, including bad cough, difficulty breathing or trying to catch their breath, or wheezing when not controlled by medication (like albuterol inhaler).

Follow **FEVER** guidance.

**RETURN WHEN IMPROVING-**if your child will need medication on returning contact the school to let them know

**Sore Throat:** Mild symptoms-student is ok to attend school.

**STAY HOME ANDS SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION:** With a severe sore throat (difficulty swallowing, breathing, or continuous drooling).

**RETURN WHEN IMPROVING.** If taking antibiotics, can return if improving and taken antibiotic for at least 12 hours. Follow **FEVER** protocol.

**Ear or Eye Irritation:** Ok to attend school with MILD symptoms. Recommend frequent hand washing.

**STAY HOME AND SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION:** for difficulty seeing or hearing, and eye injury or pain they cannot tolerate.

**Rash:** Ok to attend school with MILD symptoms.

**STAY HOME AND SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION:** if rash is worsening, causing pain, has blisters, or is not healing.

**RETURN WHEN IMPROVING** or as guided by a healthcare provider. In general, for conditions such as lice, impetigo, ringworm, scabies, and pinworms, return as soon as they start appropriate treatment.

**Overall, stay home if any new illness prevents the child from participating meaningfully in routine activities.**

**MEDICATIONS:** Don't forget that **ALL MEDICATIONS** at school whether **Prescription** or **Over-The-Counter (OTC)** require a physician's order and a medication permission form can be obtained at each school or our district webpage.
