- I. Call to Order/Moment of Silence/Mission Statement/Pledge of Allegiance (2:49:10)
- II. Comments by Visitors & Delegations (2:50:45)
 - Steve Stanganelli 12 Amidon Ave Encouraged the committee to look at schedule changes to allow for greater time during lunch and recess.

Mr. Webster moved to suspend Policy BDD, second by Mr. Noyes. Approved unanimously.

- III. FY 24 Budget Discussion (2:53:00) Superintendent McAndrews began the discussion by sharing that she had modified the budget based on committee input to reinstate the middle school world language teacher. The committee discussed the proposed budget and proposed reductions, as well as comments heard during the public hearing. A vote on the budget will take place on April 3.
- IV. School Year 22-23 Calendar Revision (3:22:36) Superintendent McAndrews summarized revisions to the calendar. The revisions reflect the need to provide packing and moving time based on the building moves taking place at the end of the school year.
 Mr. Webster moved to approve the revised calendar, second by Dr. Jurist Levy. Approved unanimously.
