

School Clinic Data

- Last school year HW team had 269,981student/staff encounters
 - That is a 2.5% increase over the prior year
 - Chronic Condition visits were up 11% in the same period (60,630 visits)
 - These require a care plan and often specialized training
 - This is the pool for potential Medicaid billing
 - <u>diabetic care</u>





Partnerships and New Initiatives Parkview Community Nurses/New records for FACE clinic in 2024:

- •We gave over 5,000 vaccines (to 1849 students) for the first year ever.
- •We did a record number of vision screenings and referrals
 - •631screened (70 referred for care)
- We did a record number of hearing screenings
 - •418 screened (8 referred for care)
- •We got the Most Innovative Research Award from Parkview Health
- •We saw the highest number of families served since 2019
 - •278 families
 - Most non-English speaking and new to the district
 - •556 referrals for food, health insurance, medical care, mental health and other social services



- SUPER SHOT.
 THE VACCINE EXPERTS
- Flumist and Other In-School Immunizations
 - 4400 flumist doses
 - 5th and 11th grade in school shot clinics running March through May



- Staff immunizations
 - Flu (879) and Covid Vaccination (647)
 - Tdap and Pneumonia vaccination Coming in February





Partnerships and New Initiatives Telehealth

neighborhood

- The goal is to remove barriers and increase access to healthcare.
- Now available in 20 FWCS Schools with the plan to increase to 30 schools later this spring. We have equipment to build infrastructure for all schools.
- The visit is facilitated by school nurse or mental health therapist
- Parent able to give consent and attend the visit via their phone
- Translation services are available.
- Health insurance is billed by Neighborhood Health and there is sliding scale payment option for those without health insurance

- SchoolCare-Electronic Health Record
- FWCS Technology Department





Barriers

- No state support for how to easily document nursing services
- We only receive the federal portion of the billing. The state portion (30%) does not contribute
- Tedious work for school nurses to obtain all documents necessary
- We had to develop a method for communicating we had everything in place to bill
- Much of the process needed to be manual in the beginning and remains so at the present time
- We uncovered many errors when the two systems interface
 - Required tweaking within reports from both Frontline and SchoolCare
 - Required some modifications for school nurse documentation
