

What is Title 1?

Title 1 is a law under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 which provides federal funds for compensatory educational services.

What is Title 1?

-Compensatory means "extra".

-Title 1 provides extra money for teachers, instructional assistants, funding for staff development, and additional materials and supplies in all subject areas for eligible schools.

How Do We Qualify For Title 1 Funds?

- Title I schools within the district are selected based on information obtained from:
 - The 135th Day Attendance Count
 - The percentage of students who are PIP (Pupils in Poverty).
- A poverty index for all of the schools in the district is determined and the schools are ranked from highest poverty index to lowest.
- Richmond Drive is one of 9 schools served with RHS funding.

Who Benefits from Title 1 Funds?

 Richmond Drive's poverty index was determined to be 80%.

- Because our poverty index is greater than 40%, we qualify as a Schoolwide Title 1 Program.

 That means all students benefit from these extra funds and services.

MTSS Title 1 / Parent Interventionist (Mrs. Marvel)

- Works with individual teacher in the MTSS process.
- Works with parents sharing Title 1 information.



Reading Recovery (Mrs. Rodgers)

Works with individual students and small groups in reading



Math Coach (Mrs. Church)

Meets with teachers monthly and supports them in classrooms.



Interventionist (Mrs. Bomar)

Works with students in reading and math intervention



- Supplies Reading and Math

- Guided Reading Books, Phonics Supplies and other reading materials
- Math Manipulatives to assist with learning math strategies

Professional Development

- Monthly meetings with the math and reading coach discuss data and progress
- Leader in Me training
- MTSS support for struggling students

Parent and Family Support

- Title 1 Parent and Family Engagement Nights materials, supplies, books, etc.
 - Game Night, Math Magic, Summer Lunch and Learn, and more!
