

Projected Cost

Bond Amount and State Aid:

- Total bond amount is \$94.9 million.
- Nearly 12% covered by State Aid, reducing the local tax burden. We only get State Aid if the referendum passes.

Tax Impact on Homeowners:

- For the average assessed home in Lawrence Twp, the estimated tax impact is \$329 per year.
- That's \$27.42 per month, or 90 cents per day.
