



### LEA and School Performance Reporting Requirement

*The Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) requires LEAs to, for each grade served by the LEA, make widely available through public means, information on each federally required assessment, other assessments required by the state, and if feasible, assessments required by the LEA (Section 1112(e)(2)(B) and Section 1111(h)(2)).*

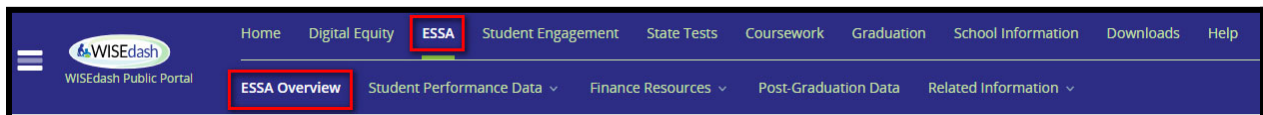
*This technical assistance document is intended to support LEAs in meeting this requirement.*

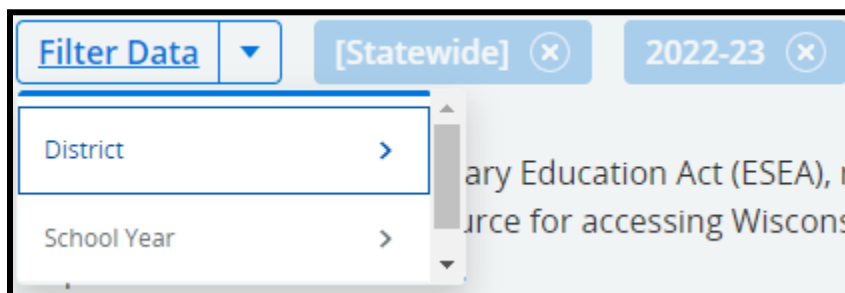

#### Step-by-Step Instructions to Get your LEA’s Link to WISEdash

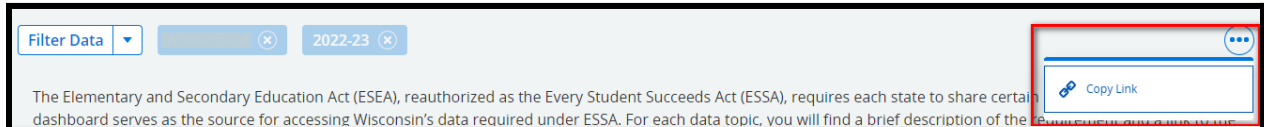
- Access the [WISEdash Public Portal](#);
- Navigate to “ESSA” in the blue menu bar, then select “ESSA Overview” (screenshot below);



- Filter to your LEA and the applicable year on the left hand side of the webpage (screenshot below);



- Once on the district ESSA Overview page, navigate to the three dots on the right hand side of the screen labeled “Dashboard Tools”, and select “Copy Link” (screenshot below);



Once you obtain your LEA's WISEdash link, move forward with sharing the link and [WISEdash Help webpage](#) to your LEA's public facing website, parent guide, or bulletin to demonstrate compliance with the public assessment reporting requirements under ESEA.
