The City of St. Charles School District will REACH, TEACH and EMPOWER all students by providing a challenging, diverse, and innovative education. We recognize that a high-quality education must occur in a safe and nurturing environment which is strengthened by parent involvement and community partnerships.

The early childhood preschool program offers classes that are multi-age groupings of children ages 3 - 5 years. Learning and instruction are individualized as children progress at their own rate and experience success. Research shows that when the classroom is composed of a community of learners with a range of abilities and ages, there are measurable gains in socialization, independence, and interaction with peers. Younger children will be nurtured by older children and benefit from collaborative learning. Older children will show increased levels of competence and leadership. Consideration will be given to the balancing of ages in each classroom. All classes will employ at least one certified teacher and additional adults according to Missouri State Accreditation child to teacher ratio.

WHAT DO WE OFFER?

The St. Charles School District Early Childhood Preschool Program is an integrated program that meets children's education needs and is developmentally appropriate for all children. Experiences are provided to stimulate learning in all five developmental areas (communication, social-emotional,

cognition, adaptive, and physical) so all children may reach their potential through developmentally appropriate activities. Each child is viewed as a unique person with an individual pattern and timing of growth and development.

WHO IS WORKING WITH YOUR CHILD?

The St. Charles School District Early Childhood Preschool Program employs certified teachers with degrees in Early Childhood Education and Early Childhood Special Education. In addition to a certified teacher, each classroom has a paraprofessional who helps prepare the environment for children and facilitate their interactions with peers and adults.

WHAT IS OUR PHILOSOPHY?

The St. Charles School District Early Childhood Preschool Program operates under the philosophy that learning is child-centered, process oriented and choice driven. A variety of learning opportunities are provided in the areas of language and literacy, mathematics, self and social development, and physical development. Instruction is organized in thematic units. Children learn through play in a safe environment that fosters discovery while building on each child's strengths. Teachers facilitate the development of self-control in children by using positive guidance techniques such as modeling and encouraging appropriate behaviors, redirecting, and setting clear limits.

WHAT IS OUR CURRICULUM?

The St. Charles School District Early Childhood Preschool Program implements developmentally appropriate practices within the preschool curriculum that is aligned with the Missouri Early Learning Standards and is approved by the Board of Education. The early childhood preschool implements the Project Construct curriculum, and utilizes Conscience Discipline and Positive Behavior Supports. The focus is on play-based, hands-on learning through experiencing a variety of classroom activities. Each activity is chosen based on the developmental skills for children. This practice promotes independence and enhances thinking skills. The preschool site has outdoor and indoor play areas designed for young children.

PRESCHOOL REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION

- Enrollment is open to children who are at least 3 years old on or before July 31, 2025 and are residents of the City of St. Charles School District.
- Parents are responsible for providing transportation to and from school.
- Parents are responsible for making sure children attend school every day.
- Parents understand that their child is expected to be fully potty trained by their 4th birthday.
- Parents agree to automatic withdrawal of funds from a checking or savings account for monthly tuition payments.
- In order to be considered for a preschool classroom placement, children must complete the DIAL-4 developmental screening.

EXTENDED CARE

Morning Care is available for the AM half day and full day classrooms beginning at 6:30 a.m.
Afternoon Care is available for the PM half day and full day classrooms until 6:00 p.m.

PRESCHOOL REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION

Tuition payment via direct debit is required.
Tuition payments are auto-debited on the 1st working business day of the month.
A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve a tuition paying preschool spot.
The deposit will be applied to the May tuition payment.
A 10% discount is offered to district employees.
A 10% discount is offered to families with multiple ECC students.

FREE & REDUCED MEAL TUITION ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Reduced tuition available for applicants qualifying for free or reduced meals. To apply for tuition reduction, families must fill out a Free and Reduced Meal application. Eligibility is verified through Chartwells Food Service. Free and Reduced eligibility must be maintained in order to continue with the reduced tuition. You will receive a Free and Reduced Meal application with your enrollment packet.

TITLE I FUNDING - HALF DAY PRESCHOOL ONLY

Upon receipt of your application, your child will be screened to determine whether he/she qualifies for Title I funding. The district will offer half day preschool with 15 - 20 students attending per session. The guidelines for the Title I early childhood preschool program state that students receiving Title I funding for their preschool tuition will be enrolled based upon greatest need and **must be residents of the district.** Student need is based upon multiple criteria including performance on the DIAL-4 Assessment. These positions are offered free of charge through Title I funding. The number of Title I preschool slots are dependent upon federal funding and may vary from year to year. Once the Title I positions have been determined and filled, open tuition spaces may remain. In order to continue qualifying for a Title I preschool position, students must maintain an average attendance rate of 95%.

2025-2026 EXTENDED CHILD CARE

High quality child care for preschool students is offered to complement the preschool day. Availability is limited to a first-come, first-serve basis.
