



9TH GRADE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION:

The School Code of Illinois requires that each student entering 9th grade must have a physical examination, on the Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination Form (Must be completed by a licensed physician, an advanced practice nurse or physician's assistant. A physical examination must include: height, weight, blood pressure, BMI, diabetic screening, signatures and dates in order to be considered in compliance. Student records must show proof of immunization series according to the guidelines of the Illinois Department of Public Health; which include: Diphtheria, Pertussis, Tetanus, Polio, Measles (Rubeola), Mumps, Rubella, Hepatitis B, Varicella, Tdap and Meningococcal.)

PLEASE NOTE: The Health History section of the physical examination form (on page two) MUST be completed, signed and dated by the parent/guardian of the child.

*** ADDITIONALLY — A Completed Dental Exam Is Also Required For All Incoming 9th Graders.**

**YOUR CHILD'S 9TH GRADE PHYSICAL AND DENTAL FORMS
MUST BE DATED ON OR AFTER AUGUST 18, 2024**

**PLEASE SUBMIT COMPLETED FORMS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO PREVENT DELAYS
IN REGISTRATION AND IN YOUR STUDENT RECEIVING THEIR CLASS SCHEDULES**

* Freshman students will be excluded on the first day of school, and every day thereafter, until complete immunization records, physical examination and parent/guardian health history have been received and approved by Health Services.

* Persons utilizing either of the two allowable state exemptions for immunizations (medical contraindication or religious objection) **MUST** have their doctor complete the required exemption form in addition to the physical form.
