

Club Connection/4th/5th Grade Summer Camp Code of Conduct

Dress Code

The primary responsibility for appearance and grooming rests with the student and his/her parents/guardians.

- Provocative clothing is inappropriate in our camp setting. Some examples are low-ride pants that expose skin, shirts or tops that create a "bare midriff", camis or tops with spaghetti type straps without a shirt covering, low-cut tops, short shorts, or short/mini skirts.
 - Summer Camp will follow the PCCS District guideline of fingertip length shorts.
 - Garments that expose underclothing are not permitted.
- Clothing that advertises or promotes alcohol, tobacco, drugs, weapons or a related activity is considered inappropriate.
 - One piece or tankini suits are **required** on swimming field trips, **no** bikinis.

If your child is dressed inappropriately for summer camp, parents will receive a phone call and be expected to bring a change of clothes for their child.

Cell Phone Policy

- Cell phone use will be monitored by summer camp staff. If students violate any policies repeatedly, cell phone use will be taken away.

Music Policy

- Music may not contain any obscene language or messages.
- Any downloaded music that has a parental or explicit advisory cannot be brought to summer camp.

Movie Policy

- All movies viewed at summer camp will be G rated unless listed on the PG Movie Release Form.
- PG 13 rated movies will not be shown at summer camp.

Electronic Devices

- Games rated 'M' for mature are not appropriate for summer camp.
- Electronic devices can only be used during designated times.
