The E-Rate program, officially known as the Schools and Libraries Program, is a US federal program that provides discounts to schools and libraries to make telecommunications and internet access more affordable. The percentage we pay is based off of how many of our students get free or reduced lunch. Not everything is eligible for E-Rate. Internet access, connection between buildings and network equipment.
