ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

The mission of the Air Force Junior Reserve Officers' Training Corps (AFJROTC) program is "Developing citizens of character." Each AFJROTC class consists of three components; aerospace science (AS), leadership education (LE), and wellness. To reinforce what is taught education (LE), and wellness. Io reintorce what is taught in the classroom, instructors and cadets participate in field trips to military bases, aerospace facilities and industries, museums, civilian airports and other areas related to aerospace and leadership education.

AFJROTC units also offer the opportunity to participate in co-curricular activities to include drill and ceremonies, cadet leadership courses, honorary academic groups and fitness competitions. Additionally, community service projects are a major part of the AFJROTC experience and help instill a sense of civic pride and citizenship.

Participation in AFJROTC is voluntary and does not commit students to military service. It does not guarantee special consideration should a student choose to enter military service.
