The Carpentry program of study provides an overview to the various fields of construction and is intended to lay a solid foundation for those students entering construction careers or craft skilled areas. The program prepares students for entry-level positions on project sites by providing the basics in safety, hand and power tools, construction math, materials handling, construction drawings, rigging and employability skills.

Students will have the opportunity to earn their OSHA 10-Hour Construction Safety certification as well as the NCCER CORE certification.
