Recently, we were made aware of some harmful bullying behavior. Bullying of any kind is unacceptable and will not be tolerated at Fairview High School. We must all work together to stop-bullying. We know our families play a crucial role in communicating expectations when it comes to inclusive behavior for students at school. For this reason, we are asking parents/guardians for your help. Please have a conversation with your child so that they understand the impact their conduct has on their peers and the role they all individually play in building an inclusive and respectful school community. This includes the use of slurs and microaggressions regarding race, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, social class, ability, gender, culture, home language, or appearance. Slurs of any kind are never "jokes." Slurs are hateful, hurtful, and harmful to our whole community.

Please, encourage your child to speak up and report when they see or hear of inappropriate behavior, including slurs or microaggressions. As always, they are encouraged to connect with a trusted adult, including their teacher, counselor, or an administrator. Anyone can make a report. If there is a threat to safety, an anonymous report can also be made via Safe2Tell. All student and community reports are taken seriously and will be investigated; students found responsible for bullying, harassment, discrimination, and/or harmful impact to others will have consequences and potential restorative opportunities in line with district policy.

It takes all of us standing up against bias and hate to make our school and our community a welcoming and supportive place for everyone. We ask that our community comes together to make sure that bullying and discrimination are not a part of the Fairview High School experience.


Key School Updates and Reminders

Fairview Vision & Hearing Screening, Tuesday, 02/11/2025

Students selected for screenings include **9th graders** during their Language Arts class, 10th-12th graders enrolled in Soc. Dev., Learning Lab, or Math Lab, new BVSD students, and those previously monitored by BVSD.



Referrals can also be made by parents or teachers if there is a concern. Students with corrective lenses should bring or wear them to the vision screening. Only students with potential vision or hearing concerns will be contacted after the screening; no contact will be made if both screenings are passed. 




