#### **Program Updates**

**Prevention Progs-.** Tabling in all areas has been on-going @ several sites district-wide. We have a wide reach but are looking for training opportunities @ sites.

TUPE: YAS on Oct 30<sup>th</sup> @ Mesa Verde – promoting anti-smoke/vape. Armoni presenting – CLUBS FNL and CL. Discuss how they will disburse anti-tobacco information to community. We have 2 Specialists in cessation. In process of advertising training for these programs.

SUPE: Teen Intervene. 3-session intervention program for substance use (vaping etc.) w/ facilitator trained by us. 4 Session parent component. BPP - Vanessa: Oct is bullying prevention month. Out at school-sites doing tabling and disseminating information. Back to school nights as well as interactive student interaction at non Back-to-School events. Various schools. Other schools up-coming. Safe School Ambassadors (SSA) program is running at two sites and working on other sites being on-boarded soon. A few new schools.

**Nutrition Srvcs** - Sneh: National School Lunch week "Find your Treasure" fish on menu for Fridays for diverse population. Last Thurs Oct. 10 was "California Crunch Day" crunchy veg/fruit for schools. Cal Universal Meals Program offers 1 breakfast & 1 lunch to all students while on campus... continuing. Nutrition dept. participating in nutrition education "Harvest of the Month". Past year completed State Admin Review – visiting 8 schools and reviewing how program works. *HALAL food options in the future?* Not currently available due to various logistical issues. Send out word that we're trying. **POSSIBLE VEGAN OPTIONS** in the future.

**Student Voice Advocacy** - Christina Sparks – BSU 19 participating in recent planning event. Ended day w/ DJ, games & crafts w/ P.P. staff assistance. Networking, info. Sharing, resources. Started LCAP listening sessions. Halfway through H.S. this week. Going well (15-25 students in ea. Listening session. Facilitated by students) Participants in these clubs is chosen by school site coordinator. They find space and student participation of their school community. Taking into account demographics and school populations.
