

WHAT CAN I EXPECT AT A TYPICAL ECFE CLASS?

Parent-Child Activity: Time for you and your child to learn and play together, with songs, stories, and developmentally appropriate activities.

Parent Discussion: Spend time with other parents discussing the joys and challenges of parenting while learning effective, research-based parenting strategies. A licensed parent educator will guide the discussion and share information about child development.

Children's Learning Time: In classes where children and parents separate for the parent discussion, children will stay with licensed early childhood teachers. Children will learn social-emotional skills while playing and learning with other children.





WELCOME TO BABY TALK!

A New FREE Weekly Class for Babies & Caregivers

Give your baby a strong start. This class is for newborn through 6 months babies and their significant caregivers: mom, dad, grandparents, etc. Meet new friends and enjoy bonding time with your baby!

Class starts with a weekly baby weigh-in and getting your questions answered about eating and sleeping. Rotating curriculum includes topics such as tummy time, adjusting to parenthood, infant brain development, illness, feeding, nutrition, relationship changes, self care, attachment, language, music, literacy, perinatal mood and anxiety disorders (PMADS) and baby blues, safety, crying, fussiness, play is learning and returning to work.

These baby classes are offered free of charge, no registration is required, co-facilitated with public health and guest speakers that are experts on their topics. There will also be time to connect with others that are going through this stage.

ECFE CLASSES

When do ECFE classes start and end?

School Year-long Classes begin on Sept. 8 and run through May 29. This aligns with the school district calendar for non-school days. Registrations are accepted year round based on availability and fees are prorated.

Seasonal Classes are scheduled in three sessions throughout the school year. They align with the school district calendar for non-school days. There are classes that start in September (fall), December (winter), and March (spring).

What is the difference between seasonal classes and school year-long classes?

ECFE classes run in two separate schedules to give your family flexibility. The school year-long schedule allows the same group of families to stay together for the full school year. The seasonal session allows increased flexibility for your calendar. Both the seasonal and school year-long classes will cover similar topics and lessons.

Can I take more than one seasonal class?

Yes, you can sign up for one or all three in a school year. Class content and topics will vary based on class attendees. Please note, some content may repeat.

What is the difference between a non-separating, gradual separating, and separating class?

In a non-separating class, parents stay with their children for the entire class. In gradual separating, there is a transition from parent/child time to separate time over the course of the class. Our separating classes include parent discussion held in a separate room. Parent discussion is included in all classes.

Where are classes held?

All ECFE classes are held at the Community Education Building, 8100 School Road, Eden Prairie, MN 55344. Enter Door 11.

What resources are available for children with special needs?

Early Childhood and Family Education classes are inclusive of all children and families. Our program staff have a strong collaboration with Early Childhood Special Education staff and work together as a team, including parents, to best meet the learning and developmental needs of all children.

How much do ECFE classes cost?

The cost of classes are based on the sliding fee scale below. They are designed to be affordable for all families to attend.

What if I have other children who need care during class (i.e. Sibling Care)?

Care is available for siblings of children registered in ECFE classes for a fee. Space is limited. Babies through 5-year-olds participate in our child centered sibling care classrooms. Staff provide a flexible, fun learning environment which includes games, songs, art activities, and child-directed play.

Our experienced staff provide a safe, secure environment for your child that includes:

- Gentle, loving care
- Feeding and diapering per parent request

Registration is required for sibling care and registration is only available by contacting us at EPS_LittleEagles@edenpr.org or 952-975-7200. Please note registering for an ECFE does not automatically enroll in sib care. Space is limited. No drop in care available, must register for the entire session/class.

ECFE classes are priced on a sliding fee scale based on your household income. Payments for seasonal classes are made one week before the start of each season. For year-long classes, payment is charged three times per year - on September 2, November 24, and February 23rd.

Fees for Parenting Education (parent only) classes, Fantastic Fridays, Music Beat, and Outdoor ECFE at Staring Lake Outdoor Center are listed separately and due at the time of registration.

The outdoors provides unique stimulation and heightens sensory experiences that can't be replicated indoors. Activities will be led by a licensed teacher and naturalist with time built in to explore. A parent educator will provide additional information on ways to support and engage your child in nature. Are you struggling to get your child to listen, follow directions or manage their big emotions? Are you ready to learn some new strategies that will help you gain cooperation and connect with your child? Join us for this 9-week parent only on-line class that will give you the opportunity to reflect, create a plan, and practice new strategies in a safe environment with other parents. You will learn key strategies to promote your child's social and emotional skills, understand your child's challenging behavior, and use positive approaches to help children learn appropriate behavior. Positive Solutions for Families is an evidence-based workshop developed by the National Center for Pyramid Model Innovations and facilitated by a Parent Educator.

MINDFUL PARENTING

In this five week online class we will discuss ways to be a more mindful parent, learning how to respond rather than react in stressful parenting situations. Mindful parenting means that you bring your conscious attention to what's happening, instead of getting seized by your emotions. Managing our own emotions and behaviors is the key to teaching kids how to manage theirs. Parenting young children can be difficult, let's support each other and learn skills to be more mindful of our responses to our children.

Have you scheduled your child's Early Childhood Screening? Make an Appointment TODAY!

Join us at Early Childhood Screening as soon as your child turns 3!

This is a FREE and simple check of how your child is growing and developing. It is a requirement of the State of Minnesota for all 3-5 year olds.

WHAT AGE SHOULD MY CHILD BE SCREENED?

Screening is best completed at age 3, yet can be completed at 4 or 5. The earlier, the better! If your child will be starting Preschool/PreK or Kindergarten in the fall, or if you have a concern about your child's development, please make an appointment for Early Childhood Screening.

WHERE IS SCREENING HELD?

Screening appointments are held in the Welcome Center at 8100 School Road, Eden Prairie. Enter at the Welcome Center entrance, door #1, and they will direct you where to go.
