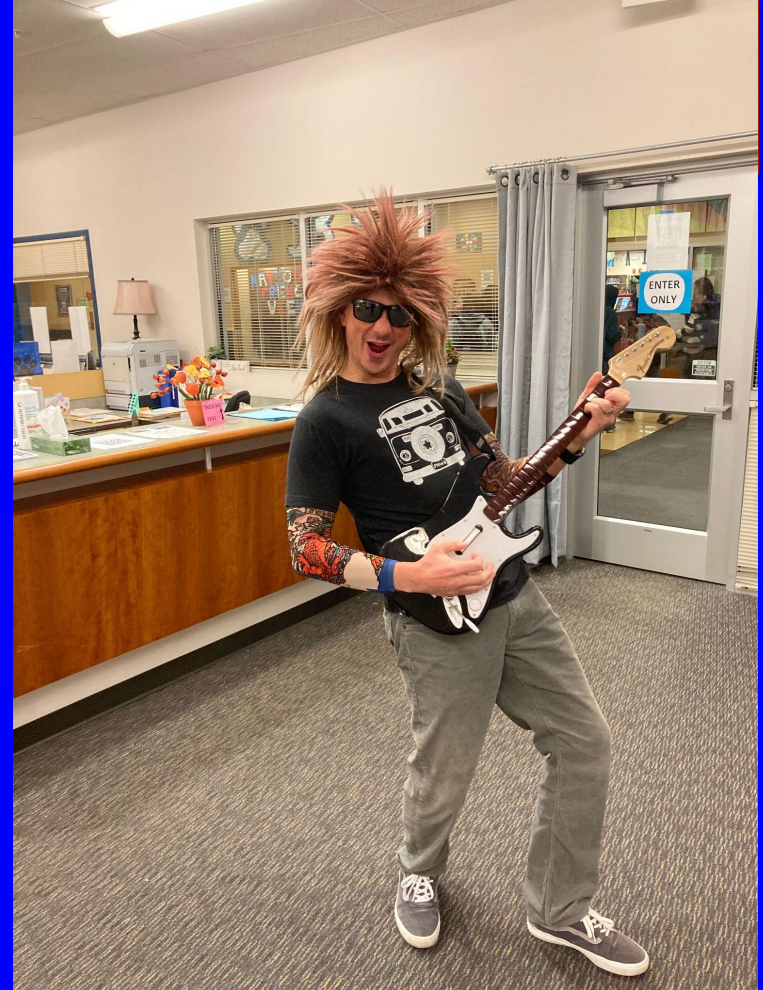

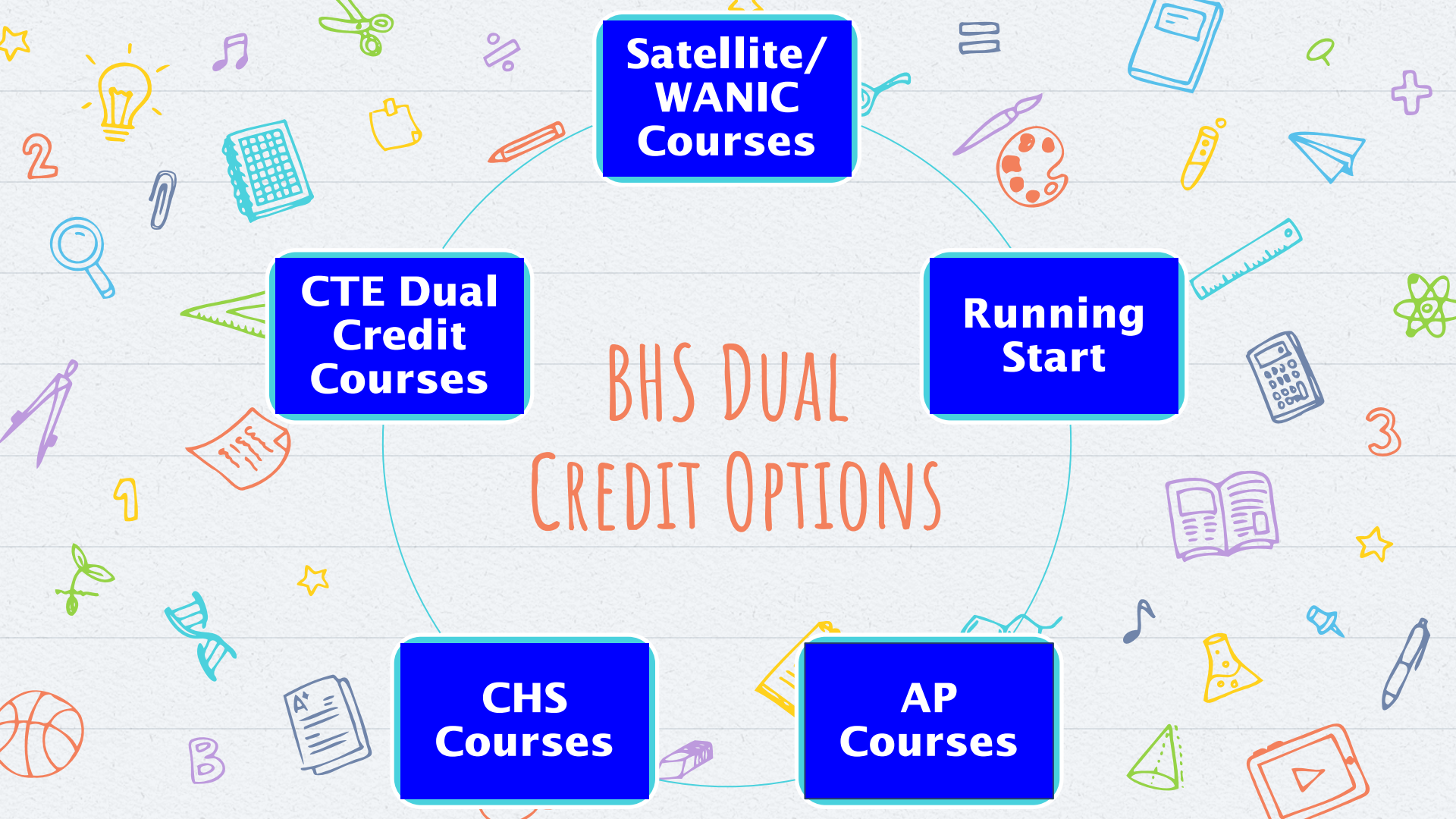

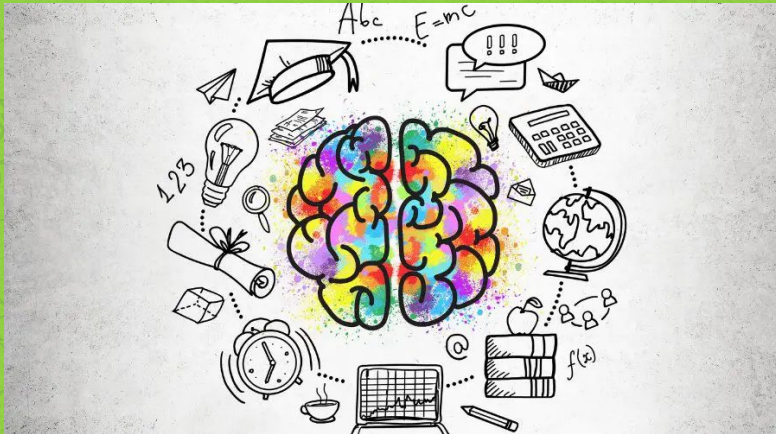

- Science (check prerequisites)




