Our Read-A-Thon starts Friday February 14, 2025 and runs until March 14, 2025.

Attendance Information:

Appointments: Due to the size of our school, we have many interruptions during the day for calling students out for appointments. We are trying to cut down on the interruptions in the classrooms and trying to find students at lunch.

If your student has an appointment during the day, please enter it into the attendance processor or send a note in with them in the morning. We can then hand them a pass immediately in the morning rather than calling them down in the middle of a class.

We write out the passes for 10 min. before their pick up time. This gives them the time to get their things, sign out, and be ready and waiting for you.
