# APS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Total credits required to graduate = **25**

- **English** – 4 credits
- **Math** – 4 credits
- **Science** – 3 credits
  - 9<sup>th</sup> – Biology
  - 10<sup>th</sup> – Chemistry
  - 11<sup>th</sup> – Physics
- **Social Studies** – 4 credits
  - 9<sup>th</sup> – Health (half credit)
  - 10<sup>th</sup> – World History
  - 11<sup>th</sup> – U.S. History
  - 12<sup>th</sup> – Economics + Government
  - New Mexico History (half credit)
- **PE** – 1 credit (ROTC or Marching Band 2 years)

**Electives** = 9 credits, to include:

- One unit of a career cluster course, workplace readiness course, or a language other than English
- **Sophomores are not allowed to serve as student aides.**

## IMPORTANT:

**COLLEGE ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENT**  
**2 years in the SAME foreign language**  
(required by many colleges/universities)

# APS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

As part of your **25 credits**,

Students must complete 1.0 credit of at least one **AP, Honors, online (DE), or dual-credit (CNM or UNM)** course.

- *This 1.0 credit must be in the same course.*
- **Cannot mix/match** different courses to complete this requirement.

*Do NOT wait until senior year to complete this requirement!*



*Examples:*

1. Honors Alg. II/Trig - .5 credit fall + .5 credit spring
2. AP US History - .5 credit fall + .5 credit spring
3. 1 CNM or UNM Dual Credit Course (free)
4. eCademy online (DE) classes = 1.0 credit (semesters 1 & 2 of the same course)

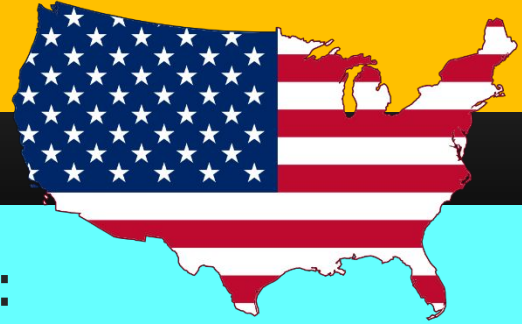

# COURSE SELECTION/PRE-REGISTRATION PROCESS

- The CHS Course Schedule is built on course selections students make in February
- Student course selections will be considered **FINAL**
- Only exception is if we determine student's schedule needs to be changed to meet graduation requirements
- Students should choose course selections **VERY** carefully
- Students are encouraged to seek assistance and advice from their parents/guardians, teachers, & school counselor

# SCHEDULE CORRECTIONS

All students are expected to continue & complete the courses they select

## 4 Reasons for Schedule Corrections

1. Completion of summer school coursework
2. Failed courses from previous semesters
3. Changing to a course with a higher degree of difficulty in the same subject area
4. Fulfillment of a graduation requirement

**Any corrections must be made within the FIRST 10 DAYS of the semester through your school counselor**

# CREDIT RECOVERY

- ❑ **Core course failures** – you will need to re-take the same course & pass to earn credit.
- ❑ **Elective course failures** – you will need to take another elective course to replace the lost credit. It does not have to be the same elective course.

## **Credit Recovery Available: Plan NOW!**

- **Summer School 2025** – offered at different locations; register in April & May; cost ranges from \$250/.5 credit to \$62.50/.5 credit depending on free or reduced lunch status
- **eCademy** – 100% computer online program available Fall 2025 & Spring 2026; cost is \$25/semester registration fee; register ASAP each semester (Register for summer classes in April & May for same cost as above)
