## 4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

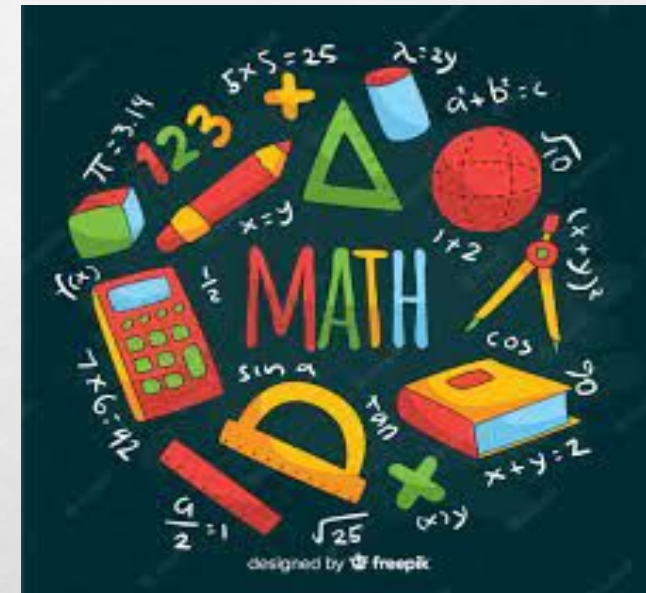
- English 12
- Journalism (yearbook)
- College Native American Literature
  - must score a 480 on SAT Reading
  - may be concurrently enrolled in LSSU's English 235
- AP English Literature
  - must score a 480 on SAT Reading
  - may be concurrently enrolled in LSSU's English 110 & 111



# MATH

## 4 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION

- Algebra II or Honors Algebra II
- SAT Math Prep (S1)/Statistics (S2)
  - If you score under a 530 on SAT Math
- Pre-Calculus
  - If you have a B- or higher in Geometry and Algebra II
- Senior math experience—all CTE classes & some science

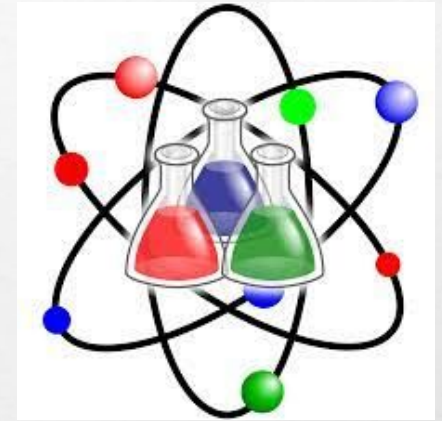

# SCIENCE

## 3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION



- Environmental Science
  - if you have completed Biology and Chemistry
- Anatomy & Physiology
- Health Science 1 or 2 (senior math credit)
- Natural Resources (2 hours, senior math credit)
- AP Biology
  - must score a 480 on SAT Reading
- Physics (senior math credit)
  - if you have done well in Honors Chemistry
  - if you are considering studying engineering or medicine in college
- College Chemistry 115 (senior math)
  - must score a 570 on SAT Math

# SOCIAL STUDIES

## 3 YEARS REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION



- US History, World History, Civics, & Economics REQUIRED
- May take as electives:
  - AP US History (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)
  - AP US Government (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)
  - AP Psychology (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)
  - AP World History (must score a 480 on SAT Reading)



# FINE ARTS

**1 CREDIT REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION (or 2 if you only took one year of world language)**

- Drama
- Concert Band
- Choir
- Basic Art
- Adv Drawing & Painting (must have taken Basic Art)
- Pottery (must have taken Basic Art)
- Studio Art (must have taken Adv Drawing)
- Art Portfolio (must have taken Adv Drawing)
- Journalism
- Digital Business (1 or 2 hours)
- Business Administration (1 or 2 hours)
- Machining (1 or 2 hours)
- Welding (1 or 2 hours)
- Woodworking
- Drafting

## IF YOU WANT TO PLAY A COLLEGE SPORT:

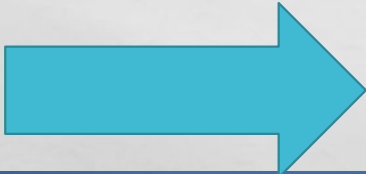
- You must be NCAA eligible

Make sure you have 7 credits and include 3 alternates in case you don't get a class you requested.

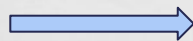
