- C. Funds update \$2,413
 - a. Feedback on Triple Play Night
 - i. Total earnings \$3,000, check received?-We are still waiting for the check from Triple Play. They have incorrectly addressed it twice but anticipate they will resolve this asap.
 - b. Feedback on Bingo Night
 - i. Any idea how many people/families came? How much money was raised? Approximately 200 people attended and there was a lot of positive feedback; approximately \$413 was made
 - 1. Suggested to put a flyer at Super 1 for those without social media.
- D. 8th grade Silverwood trip-LMS admin and PTC board would like to see 8th graders celebrate completion of middle school with a trip to Silverwood. We are going to advertise a "Sponsor a student" campaign to raise money to cover the cost for as many students as possible. Approximate cost per student is \$30.
 - a. Cut from last year's school budget. Silverwood is closed to the public on the day the students go. \$27/per ticket + \$2.75/bus per student = \$30 (rounded up)
 - i. \$6,750 for all 8th graders to go (225)
 - 1. Talked about if all students go or if behaviors play into trip attendance.
 - b. Roll out the Sponser a Student first
 - i. Season passes can be used. 😊
