LECOM will be hosting a wonderful summer opportunity for high school students through the LECOM Bradenton's 2025 Medical Science Academy (MSA). This two-week summer experience will provide an opportunity for high school students to interact closely with faculty and medical students from the College of Medicine. Students will attend classes in large and small groups as well as participate in hands-on laboratory activities and an interactive suture skills session with volunteers from the US Army. A demonstration will be given by the East Manatee Fire Rescue as well as Manatee County EMS. Additionally, in the second week, students will receive Basic First Aid training, CPR training, Stop the Bleed training, tour Blake Hospital's trauma bays, operating rooms, step down units, emergency medical helicopter, and interact with the medical flight crew. The second week will also include LECOM Dental Day in which the students learn from LECOM faculty and participate in simulation lab as well as LECOM Pharmacy Day where students learn from LECOM faculty and participate in a compounding activity.


Joel Van Ryn


