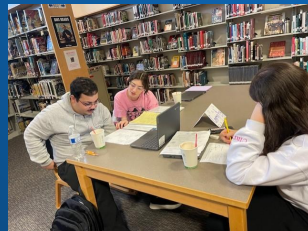
All of our clubs are student made and run. ANYONE can request to make a new club. *takes about two weeks to approve

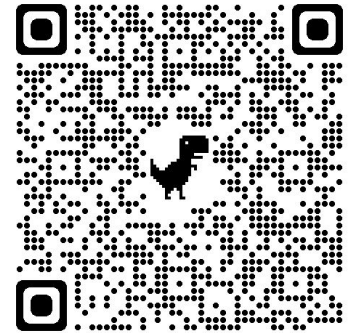



- **March 6** - BHS Counselors on CPMS campus for student registration check ins

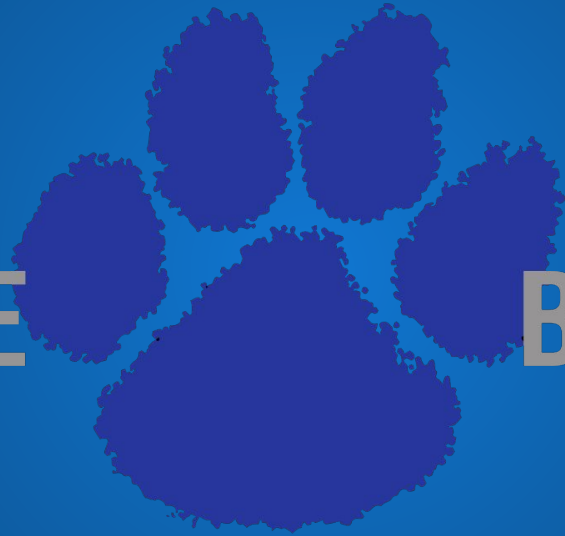
Please remember choices made by students during registration are considered to be final. Courses offered and school staffing are based on the decisions students make during the registration process
