


Expanding Participation: Offered a quieter, reflective activity for those who may not prefer high-energy events.

Exciting Prizes: The top three winners received Cane's gift cards!



Events such as pickleball and spikeball allow all students, regardless of athletic background, to participate, fostering inclusivity while encouraging peer connection.




GAME OF THE WEEK


