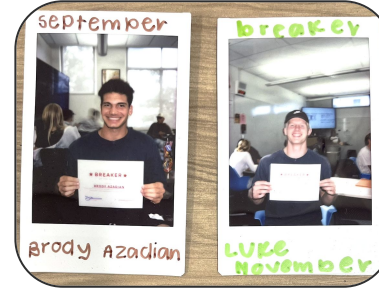

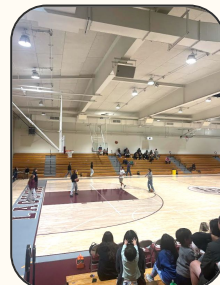
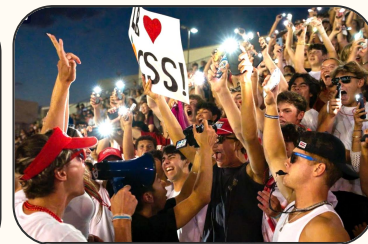

Impact on School Culture:

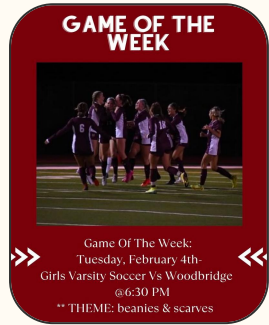
Fosters inclusivity by highlighting athletes who might go unnoticed, creating a supportive, unified school community where all achievements are valued.

 **38%** reduction in D/F semester grades over the past 2 years

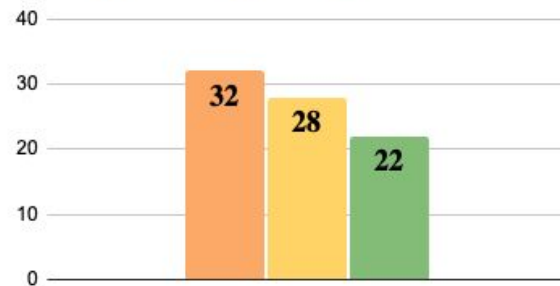
