WHAT COURSES CAN A CCP STUDENT TAKE AT LEC?

- ① If the student meets the prerequisites for the coursework, all undergraduate coursework is typically available for CCP students to enroll in
- ② Some restrictions may apply based on course placement or area of interest

CCP ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Application for Admission (*lec.edu*)
- Preferred Cumulative (Overall) GPA of 3.0 in High School Courses
- Guidance Counselor Recommendation Form
- Standardized Test For Course Placement
 - ACT or SAT
 - Reading Accuplacer at Lake Erie College

Test scores are NOT required if GPA is above a 3.0 and student is entering 10th, 11th, or 12th grade

DEADLINES FOR LAKE ERIE COLLEGE*

- April 15th: Deadline to Apply to LEC
- May 17th: Deadline for Accuplacer (if needed)
- May 31st: Deadline for Course Registration
 - *This is for students taking classes through Lake Erie College, and not through a partnership program with their high school*
- Once accepted, students will participate in a CCP orientation
 - *More information to come on orientation*
