Seventh grade science students have been learning about our solar system. They all worked extremely hard creating the solar system out of different types of medium.



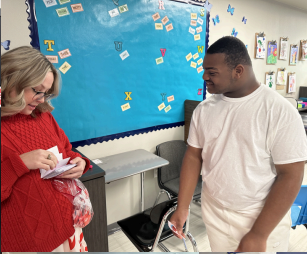

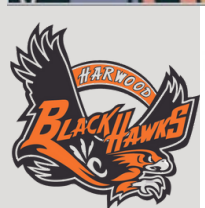
