## Notice of Academic Expectations for Continued Enrollment

*It is important that all students reach their academic potential and make progress towards graduation:*

During the 2024-25 school year, students are expected to practice appropriate academic behaviors, participate in weekly contact meetings with their teacher, and have good academic standing. In order to maintain enrollment at Seaview Academy, students are expected to adhere to these expectations and make Adequate Academic Progress. Adequate Academic Progress is defined as On Track Progress according to a student's WSLP and earning grades over 60% in the majority of their classes.

In the initial three weeks of enrollment, students will be expected to make Adequate Academic Progress and participate in the required contacts with teachers. If these expectations are not met, the student may immediately be returned to their prior school of record.

After the initial three weeks of enrollment, if a student is not meeting academic expectations despite intervention plans being administered, Seaview staff will meet to determine whether a student needs additional supports through Seaview or will be better served at their home district school. If a decision is made that a student will be transferred, Seaview staff will help coordinate the transition out of Seaview Academy.
