Where is Graduation?

- Commencement will take place on **Monday, June 2nd at the Minneapolis Convention Center.**
- **Parking will be at a reduce rate**
- **The ceremony will be streamed**



When is Graduation?

Highview seniors will walk with Armstrong or Cooper High Schools.

- **Cooper High School: 12:30 pm**
(arrive 1 hour ahead)
- **RVA High School: 3:30 pm**
(arrive 1 hour ahead)
- **Armstrong High School: 6 pm**
(arrive 1 hour ahead)

How many people can I invite to graduation?

Armstrong: Each graduate will receive 6 tickets for graduation when cap/gowns are picked up.

Cooper: Each graduate will receive 6 tickets for graduation when cap/gowns are picked up.



Critical Timeline

- Cycle 4: February 25-April 17
- Cycle 5: April 20-June 4
- **All Graduation Grades Due:
Friday, May 16**
- **Cap and Gown Pickup: May 27
and 28, 8am to Noon**



All of your work must be turned in by May 16th and grades must be entered or you won't be cleared for graduation!

When is the last day of school?

Seniors in Good Standing: Last IN PERSON Day is Wednesday May 28, 2025

Seniors Close to Graduating: Thursday May 29 and Friday May 30 are optional for seniors that still need to complete coursework towards graduation - these can be in person or asynchronous

ALL Grades 10-12: Monday, June 2nd is an asynchronous day for ALL grades 10-12. All staff will attend one of the graduation ceremonies

Meet with Sarah in the front office to complete an exit interview and turn in your chromebook. If you don't meet with Sarah, your name will not be in the commencement program and your diploma will not be printed until next school year.



Time is Running Out!

How many credits do you still need? Based on end of Cycle 4

- **8 Credits:** On track to graduate! Keep up the good work and finish strong
- **9- 10 Credits:** Think of a plan to be successful! 5-6 credits a cycle is tough, but push yourself and you can do it.
- **11 plus:** It's getting tight! Still a chance however it's time to wake up. If it's important to you, you will make it happen.
