Community School (CSLX 2022):

- “leverage resources”
- “relationship centered, supportive, and equitable school communities”
- “learning is culturally rooted, inclusive, rigorous, and relevant”

Features of a Community School:

- Community partners providing physical and mental wellness services on campuses
- On-time graduation
- Students who are excited about learning
- Strengthened student and staff relationships
- Increased academic performance
- Improved daily attendance
- Reduced acting out behavior and use of suspensions
- Families see our schools as welcoming and a place with support for their family

Next Steps:

- Determine needs via surveys, focus groups, data, and observations
- Write grants for 7 of 11 qualifying school sites Feb/March
- Grant awards are presented in May 2023
- Schools who receive the grant will have a full-time Community Schools Liaison to coordinate partnerships
