
WHEN TO KEEP YOUR ILL CHILD HOME FROM SCHOOL

As parents we have all had the following scenario happen...you're getting ready to go to work and your child says, "I don't feel good." Your mind immediately goes to all of your tasks for the day as you try to determine if your child really needs to stay home or if they should tough it out.

Keep your child home from school if they have any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (over 100 degrees)
- Lethargy
- Persistent Crying
- Difficulty Breathing
- Influenza
- Diarrhea or Vomiting





By keeping your child home, you will help to lessen the risk of spreading your child's illness to others. Also, if you see a doctor, please be sure to ask them how long your child should be out of school. Often times, children return too early and become ill again very quickly. If your child is prescribed an antibiotic they should remain home for 24 hours after the first dose. If your child has the flu, they should remain home for 24 hours after the fever and other symptoms have stopped.

Be careful to not keep your child home too quickly. Children who are absent for more than 10 days in a school year may be required to obtain physician statements for ongoing absences.

UNEXPECTED EARLY DISMISSALS

Tis' the season for unpredictable bad weather. With that in mind it is imperative that families are prepared for unexpected early dismissals. Be sure that your family has a plan in place of how your child(ren) will be getting home.

Please prepare your child with special directions in case school would be canceled during the school day. Does s/he know how to get into the house if you are not home? Does s/he know where to call you?

On days of questionable weather, cancellations will be posted on the radio, WDLB AM 1450, the District website, www.marshfieldschools.org and the Skylert Calling System will be activated. Cancellations are posted in these areas as soon as they are determined. Please do not inundate the school office with calls inquiring about cancellations without checking these other avenues first.

LUNCH ACCOUNTS

With the beginning of 2024 we would like to remind families with low lunch account balances to send money to the office. You can also pay online! Your family account balance is sent home weekly if your balance is at \$10.00 or below. Remember, students with a negative balance need to bring money or a cold lunch. If you have any questions or concerns about your account balance, feel free to call Michelle in the school office. Free and Reduced Meal applications are available online if needed.

Keep in mind that if your child is getting a milk only, or is getting an extra milk, they will be charged 50 cents for each milk.

Registration for Next School Year

- Verify your information in Skyward Family Access, Request Changes. Log into Family Access as the Student Info tab allows you to update and submit changes for district approval at any time. See request changes registration letter for directions. Students are automatically enrolled from year to year.
- If you will not be returning to the School District of Marshfield in September, notify us of the city, state, and school where you will be moving through the Family Access Contact Us tab in the upper right corner or through your school office as soon as you know.
- If you have moved during the school year or will be moving before the start of the new school year and want your child to remain at the school they are currently attending OR if you are requesting your student attend a school other than their neighborhood school for the upcoming school year, complete the Intradistrict Student Transfer Request found on Family Access under Online Forms, due by March 1.
- Students currently in public 4K will be placed at their neighborhood school for kindergarten. Children not attending public 4K may submit online enrollment for kindergarten through our website www.marshfieldschools.org, January 27-February 7.
- Students entering 4K may submit online enrollment through our website www.marshfieldschools.org, January 13-24.
- Current 6th grade students will receive further information from Marshfield Middle School.
- Open house information and teacher placement will be in Family Access in mid-August.

A Reminder about "Distribution Flags" in Skyward Family Access:

The "**Public Use**" flag is used to exclude student information from being sent outside the school district (such as product and service vendors or newspapers and other media).

The "**Local Use**" flag is used to exclude student information from within the school district like *yearbooks*, photographs, and sports information. This includes rosters, programs, or articles where students' directory information is identified.

The "**District Use**" flag is used to exclude student information from use within the school district.
