**Trashion is fashion created from used, recycled, thrown-out, found and repurposed items*

All students, TK-12, are invited to participate in the Trashion Show, featuring original trashion designs. All outfits must be student designed and made. Parent's may help with outfit assembly (ie. small amounts of sewing, hot gluing, cutting, etc. are allowed).



Students in grade spans (TK-2, 3-5, 6-8, and 9-12) will be judged in one of three categories:

1. **High Fashion:** create an outfit from recycled materials, resembling Project Runway's Unconventional Challenge
2. **Fantasy/Fiction:** create an outfit from recycled materials that resembles a character from your favorite book, TV show, or movie (think superheroes, princesses, science fiction characters, etc.)
3. **Around The World:** create an outfit from recycled materials that represents any of the world's cultures

Prizes for each category will be awarded for the:

1. Most Creative
2. Best Use of Recycled Materials

Participants will wear their "trashion" outfits at the 2025 Science Odyssey event on April 10th at Joe Michell K-8 School. Participants will take part in the fashion show, have their pictures taken, outfits judged, and awards will be presented later that evening. Check in and staging will begin at 4:30pm, the show will be at 5:30pm and awards will be given out at 6:30pm.
