This past week was a challenging one, filled with many rumors that all turned out to be unsubstantiated. In the event of such claims, each of these rumors are always taken very seriously and investigated alongside law enforcement, according to our Okemos Public Schools Threat Assessment Process. As a building, we try to communicate information to our community as soon as possible, however, we ask that all stakeholders remember that we are working with minors, and certain information cannot be shared.

I would also like to remind individuals that posting rumors without facts on social media only causes additional worry for families and adds additional time to the investigation process. We ask that you provide time for the process to be carried out so that facts can be gathered, the actual investigation can occur, and then accurate information can be shared with stakeholders in as timely of a manner as possible.
