CELL PHONE AND SMART WATCHES POLICY REMINDER

We ask that you please take a moment to review and remind your child of the Cell Phone and Smartwatch policy.

"Cell phones and other communication devices are to be turned off and placed in the locker upon entering the building. They are not to be used during the school day unless a teacher has given permission for use in their classroom. They may be used after school for purposes of contacting parents for pick up. If a staff member hears the phone or a student is seen using the phone, the staff member will confiscate the device and turn it into the office."

Unfortunately, smartwatches and cell phones are becoming a major distraction for our students. If you need to contact your child during the school day, please call the office. Furthermore, if your child needs to contact you throughout the school day, we require them to use the office phone as well. Students caught playing on their

smart watches or cell phones will have them confiscated and will require a parent to pick them up at the end of the day.
