Students will work with their teachers in support of school activities or non-profit and for-profit organizations to meet community needs. Examples of past projects are organizing food drives, recycling programs, and service projects that involve working within our community and for our school community.

Application Process



- ✗ Applications **must** have the required eligibility documents attached or they won't be considered (see Student Eligibility below)
- ✗ All students **must** submit an online transfer application in addition to the documents. See district website.
- ✗ Students residing and attending in another district will **also** have to submit an Inter District Transfer application available from that district office of residence. This will be required if accepted, and does not need to be submitted now.

Student Eligibility:

- ✓ If using letter grades, the equivalent of a 3.0 GPA or higher each semester in 4th and 5th grade; no D or F grades. Students on a Standards Based report card must have "2" or higher scores each semester during 4th grade, **AND** "2" or higher scores on their 5th grade 1st semester and 3rd quarter progress report. *
- ✓ Students **must** have a "3" or "4" score in College and Career Readiness on their 5th grade, 3rd quarter report card. **
- ✓ Scores at or above 70th percentile on the NWEA 5th grade, 3rd quarter Language Arts **AND** Math Assessments. Out of district students must show proficient levels on their 5th grade district assessments. ***
- ✓ An **average** of 10 or fewer absences when looking at both 4th and 5th grade attendance. ***

* - Students who meet grade requirements, but have multiple "2" scores, will be considered if space is still available after considering students who meet grade requirements and have "3" and "4" scores.

** - Students from out of district must have an A/B or equivalent score in citizenship (or similar category) on their 5th grade report cards.

*** - Quarantine absence codes do not factor into this number. Students who don't meet the bottom two criteria may still apply; however, they will only be considered if space is available after acceptance of all students that meet all levels of eligibility.
