



### History and Founding Principles

St. Stephen's Episcopal School is a pioneering coeducational school serving 706 boarding and day students in grades 6 through 12. We provide a distinctive college preparatory curriculum within a balanced program of academics, service learning, athletics and the arts. Founded in 1950 by the Episcopal Diocese of Texas, the school has a rich history of teaching students of all backgrounds and cultures to live together in community. St. Stephen's was the first coeducational Episcopal school in the United States and the first integrated boarding school in the South. Our mission and core values are rooted in progressive, yet resolute, principles: honor all faiths and traditions, support equity and inclusion, respect other cultures and perspectives, promote social justice, serve others and be good stewards of the environment.

### Academic Program and Diploma Requirements

All Upper School courses at St. Stephen's are taught at an honors level or higher, and there are no advanced tracks except in mathematics and Spanish. Although the school does not offer Advanced Placement (AP) courses, our faculty designs courses with depth and complexity that goes well beyond the prescribed AP program.

### Intellectual Exploration

Deeply committed to intellectual freedom and academic rigor, St. Stephen's offers a distinctive curriculum that allows students to explore individual interests while developing skills in critical analysis, reasoned discourse and persuasive writing. Academic offerings also provide students a shared intellectual experience, bolster their sense of community and reinforce the school's core values.
