



Asynchronous Virtual Learning Days

Short-Term Plan (1–2 Days)

- Teachers will send out daily communication with the virtual day’s plan and what students should focus on in their Google Classroom.
- Students can access and complete all assigned tasks asynchronously.
- Designated office hours will be available for grades 3-8
- Teachers will be available from 8am to 3pm for correspondence regarding asynchronous learning.
- **Specials are Optional:** Teachers will share an overview of lesson plans, asynchronous work, and office hours for their subjects.

Long-Term Plan (3+ Days)

If closures extend beyond two days, remote learning will include a mix of live instruction and asynchronous tasks:

- Teachers will communicate lesson plans and office hours for each day.
- Core subject instruction will be conducted as follows:
 - **Grades K–2:** 40 minutes of live instruction (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies).
 - **Grades 3–5:** 60 minutes of live instruction (ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies).
 - **Grades 6–8:** 20 minutes of live instruction per scheduled subject.
- **Specials are Optional:** Teachers will share an overview of lesson plans, asynchronous work, and office hours for their subjects.
