

The <u>Atlanta Regional Brain Bee Competition</u> this year will be held at Emory University on <u>Saturday, March 15th</u> from <u>9:00AM-1:00PM</u>. The format of the Brain Bee Competition will consist of a preliminary written round (multiple-choice and short answer questions) and a final oral round. To prepare, participants are encouraged to participate in our workshops (February 1st and 15th) led by graduate students from Emory University and Georgia State University. Attending the workshops is NOT a prerequisite for competing in the Brain Bee and students may attend the workshops WITHOUT competing in the Brain Bee. Workshops are \$40 per person per workshop however, discounted group rates and tuition assistance is available for students who qualify for the National Free or Reduced Lunch Program at their school.
