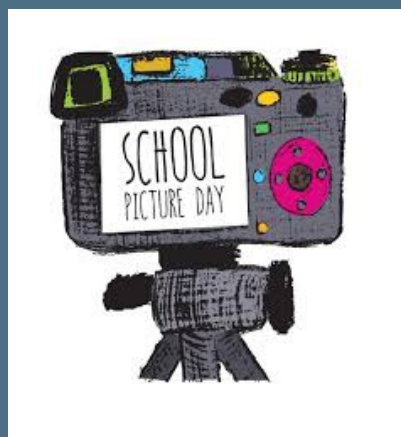
FALL PARENT / TEACHER CONFERENCES

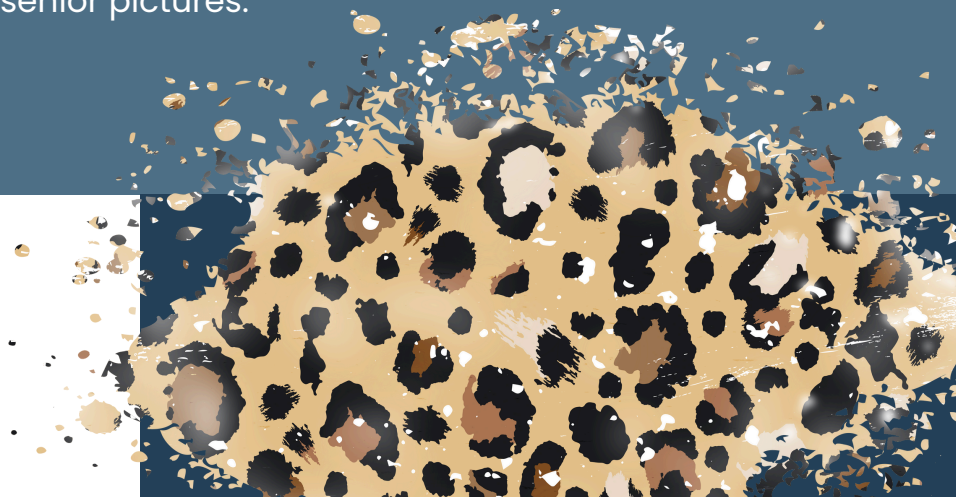

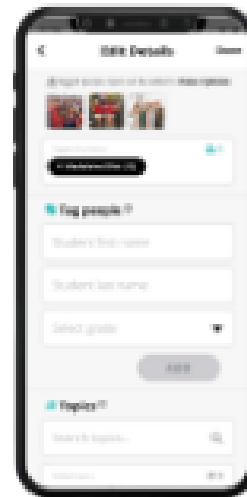
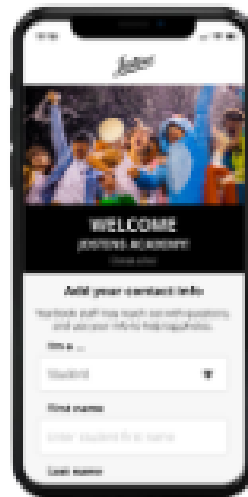
