#### **BURNETT STADIUM GUIDELINES**

#### HOME FANS, VISITORS, HEAD COACHES, & ADMINISTRATION

We welcome you to Burnett Stadium, home of the **Raymondville Bearkats**. We anticipate this year to be an exciting and successful one. We want to assure everyone who attends and participates in events at the stadium a safe environment. To achieve this, we must follow and adhere to a few guidelines within the stadium to ensure a safe environment for all fans and student athletes.

- I. Only authorized District personnel will be allowed on the sidelines during football games. Football players are to remain between 25-yard marks on their respective sidelines.
  - a. Students, parents, and private photographers are **NOT ALLOWED** on the sidelines.
  - b. News, Media, school photographers, and special assignment personnel are permitted with a sideline pass, bust must stay outside of the 25-yard mark.
- II. NO FOOD is allowed on the field or track area.
  - a. No confetti is allowed in the stadium
  - b. Spirit signs are welcomed, but the club sponsor is responsible for ensuring all of the signs and tape are removed after the game.
- III. Coaches from visiting schools must call the Athletic Director Juan F. Cantu at (956) 689-8179 EXT 4150 and let us know their ETA. Stadium crew will be ready to show them to the dressing room located at the RECHS Gymnasium.
  - a. Dressing rooms should be clean at all times.
  - b. Halftime: Home & Visiting teams must allow the school bands to finish performance; teams are to warm-up in the end zones and not exceed the 10-yard line until performances are complete.
- IV. Inflatable mascots/tunnels are welcomed on the field and must be setup in a timely manner.
  - a. Inflatable tunnel personnel must remain in their designated area, away from the field of play. During the game and halftime, personnel must return to the stands. No children are allowed to assist with tunnels. There is a limit of 6 personnel to assist with the tunnel. **Please bring your own extension cords**.
- V. Spirit team and Cheerleaders in uniform are allowed on the track but must stay away from the sideline during the game. Please keep drinking containers off the track.
- VI. Band must wait in lanes 5-8 of the track until the football players clear the field for halftime to ensure the safety of all students. All band equipment must also be kept in the outside lanes to prevent accidental injuries.




