- **Read Together Every Day** Set aside time to read with your child, whether it's bedtime stories, shared reading, or taking turns reading aloud.
- **Talk About Books** Ask open-ended questions like, "What was your favorite part?" or "What do you think will happen next?" to build comprehension.
- **Encourage a Love of Reading** Let your child choose books that interest them, including picture books, graphic novels, and non-fiction texts.
- Make Reading Interactive Use voices for characters, act out scenes, or have your child retell the story in their own words.
- **Build Vocabulary** Discuss new words, play word games, and connect words to everyday experiences to help expand their language skills.
- Model Reading Behavior Let your child see you enjoying books, magazines, or newspapers—this sets a great example!
- **Use Everyday Opportunities** Reading doesn't just happen in books! Encourage your child to read recipes, signs, menus, or instructions.

### **Student Illness Policy Reminder**

Dear Parents/Guardians,

With cold and flu season upon us, it's a good time to review Wyoming School District's illness policy to help maintain a safe and healthy school environment.

If your child has been ill with a fever, vomiting, or diarrhea, please keep them home for at least 24 hours after their last fever or gastrointestinal symptoms. Your child must be fever-free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medications such as acetaminophen (Tylenol) or ibuprofen (Advil, Motrin). This allows them time to fully recover and return to school ready for a productive day.

The 24-hour rule also applies to antibiotic treatment. If your child has been prescribed antibiotics for conditions such as strep throat or conjunctivitis ("pink eye"), they must remain home for at least 24 hours after their first dose before returning to school.

Your cooperation is essential in keeping our school community healthy. Thank you for your support in helping us create a safe learning environment for all students.
