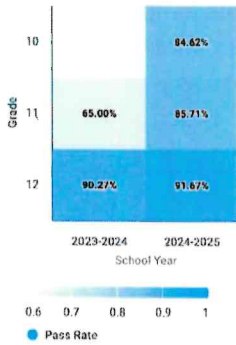

<p>We hope to achieve our 2024-2025 student achievement and course completion goals with a greater emphasis on early warning indicators such as attendance, behavior, and course completion. To that end, we are much more responsive to students when they begin to experience challenges by using one or more of these indicators. We are constantly adjusting our programming to meet the changing needs of our population and we have developed a more flexible credit recovery model which encourages students to put more effort into gaining an understanding which leads to course mastery and credit attainment. Trimester 1 data from the 23-24 and 24-25 school years was used for the report.</p> <p><i>There are several efforts including our credit recovery program, after school support, advisory process, one on one support from the counseling staff and the administrative team which play a major role in the success of our programming. With the addition of a new grade level, these efforts will be continued, monitored and adjusted as necessary to impact student achievement throughout the 2024-2025 school year.</i></p>

2024-2025 Trimester 1/Mid Year Core Subject Areas

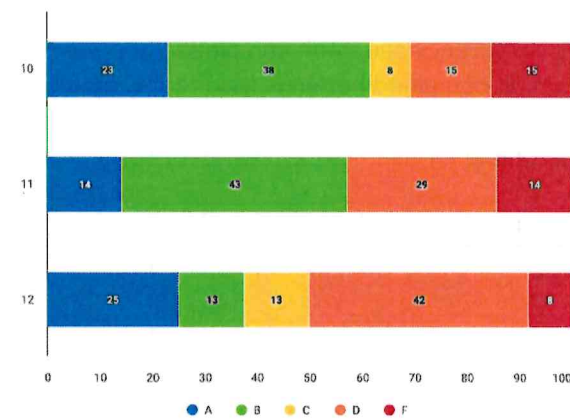

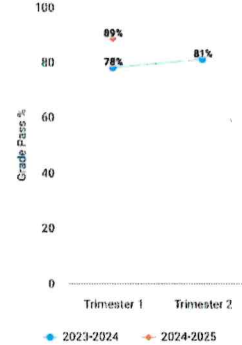


How are ELA grades distributed by grade level?

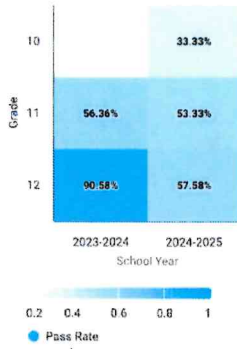

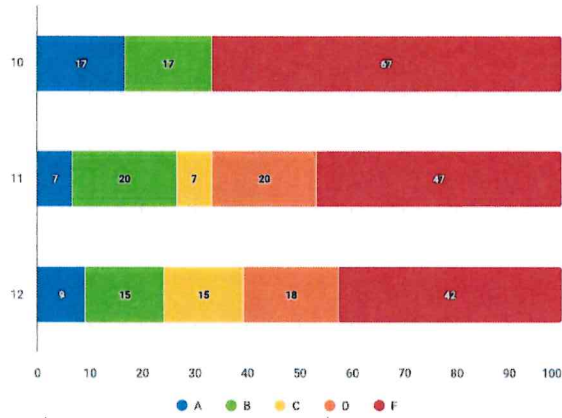

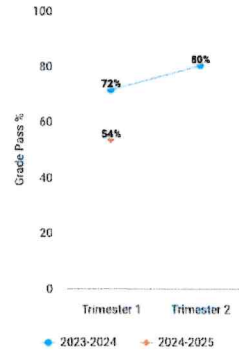


How are math grades distributed by grade level?

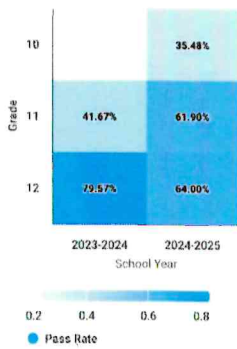

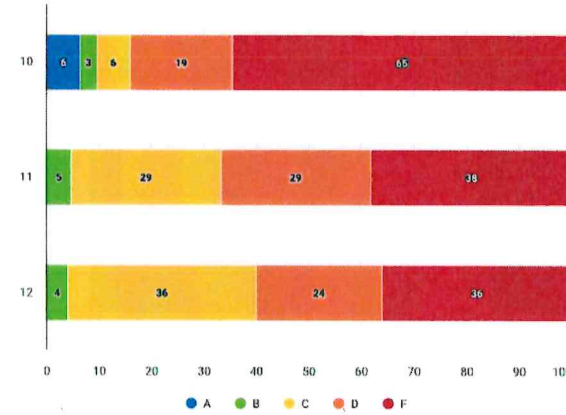

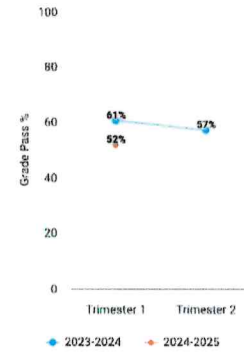


How are science grades distributed by grade level?

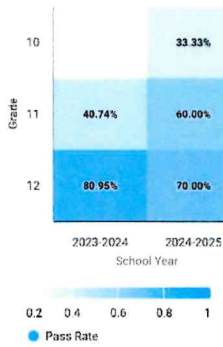

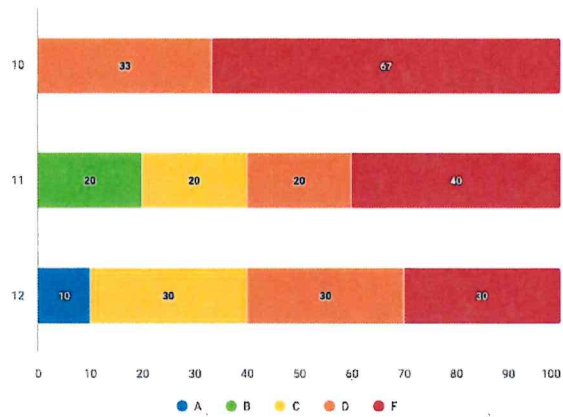

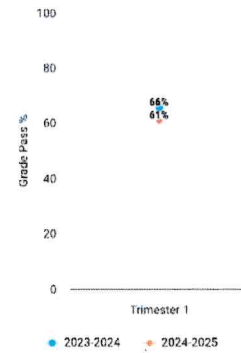


How are Social Studies grades distributed by grade level?
