GOC Assessment

Students are required to take the same assessments and tests as any student enrolled in a traditional brick-and-mortar school in Gwinnett County Public Schools (GCPS). All official exams must be taken at the Gwinnett Online Campus location during the testing windows outlined by the GCPS and the State of Georgia. Specific testing dates will be provided when available.

The following documents are the yearly assessment flyers that the county puts out at the beginning of the year, so parents know what is coming up for their child.

Gwinnett County Public Schools offers a balanced assessment system. Throughout the school year students will participate in a variety of formative and summative assessments. GOC supports the GCPS assessment plan and rigor through both in person and remote testing opportunities based on the schedule provided.

Students and families should be aware that all indicated testing windows include the main administration and all makeup testing dates. Once a testing window has concluded, assessments will no longer be available. Checking pacing guides and reading all communication regarding testing is crucial to a student's success.

Testing that takes place in a school building will require the use of a GCPS Chromebook. Due to internet connectivity, updates, and testing platform applications, student's personal devices cannot be used on campus. Please be sure to pick up your GCPS Chromebook before in-person testing takes place.
