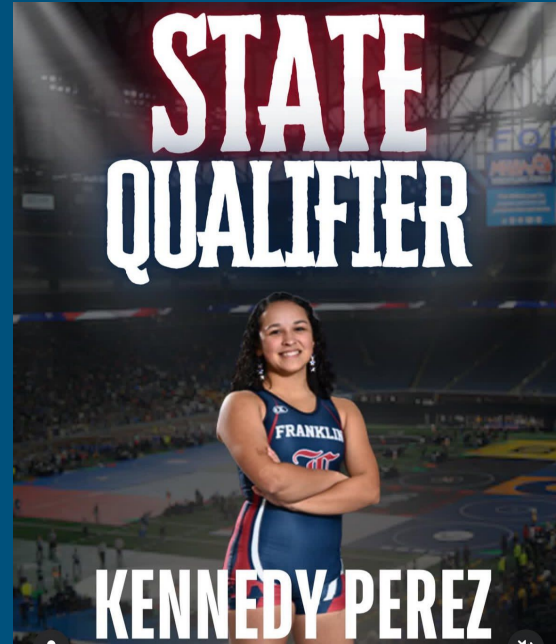
Franklin Varsity Pompon finished First Runner Up in Division 1 at the State Championships!

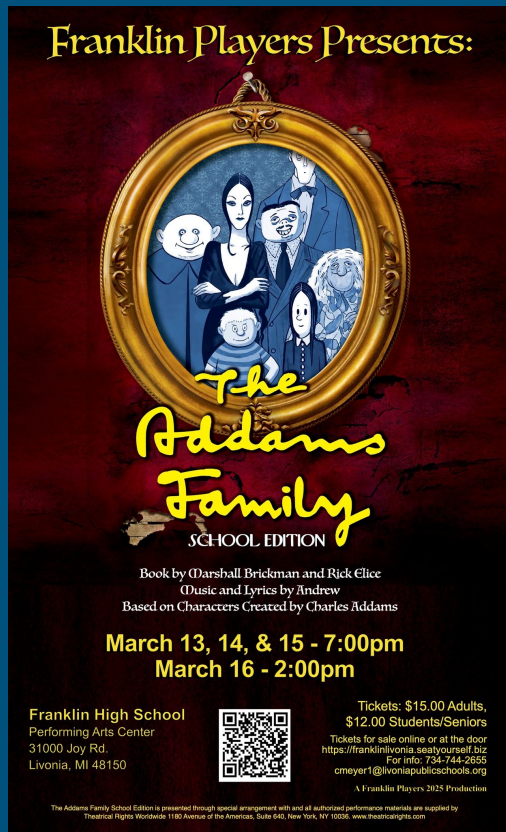

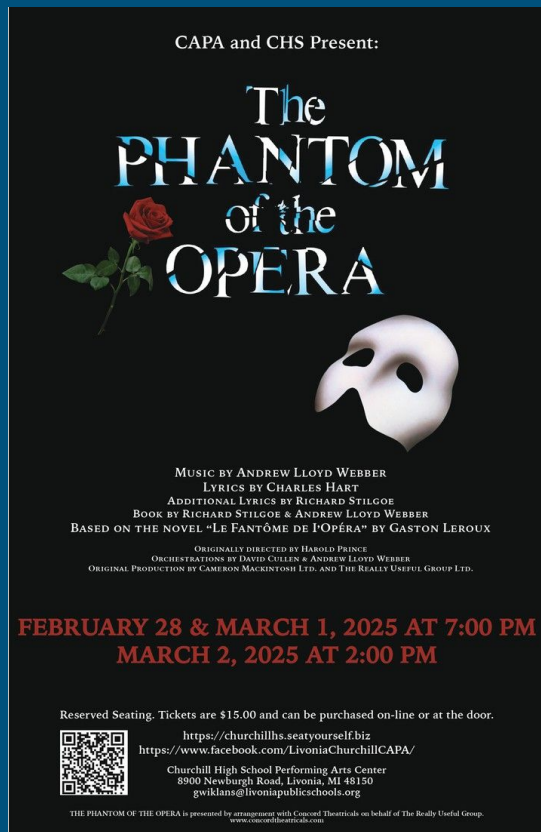
