Please follow each carefully:

- **Caps/Gown:** National Graduation Products visited the campus in November. If you have not ordered yours, please do ASAP. Visit <https://www.nationalgraduationproducts.com/> **Deadline February 15th**
- **Graduation Walk of Fame!** This is for all our students to see you and for you to be a role model. This is set right before our Senior Awards Breakfast on Thursday, May 15th at 8:45am. All seniors **MUST** be on campus no later than 8:15am. **Meet in room 39 prior. Must bring/wear your cap and gown.** The Walk will start promptly at 8:45.
- **Senior Breakfast.** To be hosted in the Dragon Nation Gym on Thursday, May 15th, breakfast will be served from 9:00-9:30 and the Awards Ceremony beginning at 9:30am. Only 4 guests maximum for each Senior. An RSVP will go out in early April.
- **Graduation Practice** (will occur on campus) will be followed by Senior Breakfast. ALL SENIORS are required to participate to be eligible to walk at graduation.
- **Graduation Ceremony Thursday, May 15th at 6:00pm.** **ALL GRADUATES MUST be in the building no later than 5:15pm, they will enter through the back gate.** Graduation will be at Mesa Arts Center in the Tom and Janet Ikeda Theater

Guidelines and Rules

- **You Must be at the Graduation Ceremony Practice to Walk.**
- **Cap and Gowns Must be Presentable.** It is your job to have your cap and gown ironed, kept clean and ready to go.
- **Must wear nice clothing under your Cap and Gown.** (Like shirt and tie and a presentable dress etc.)
- **No Balloons Allowed.**
- **During Graduation Please No Fooling Around or Disruptions, No Air Horns.** Please keep it professional.
- **If you Owe Fees or Need to Make up Credits.** You will be able to walk but you will not have your diploma handed to you, it will be empty. This is because you may need to make up credits or owe fees. Get into our office and pay those fees so we can issue your diploma that night.
- **Please let us Know if you Can't Make it by calling the office.**

**Please be respectful and on time. Wear appropriate attire for all upcoming Senior events.
