## 1. 12th Grade Required Vaccinations

Ohio requires a SECOND booster shot of the Meningitis vaccine for all students entering the 12th grade. Please submit proof of these vaccines to the office by August 15 by using either the below form filled out by a physician OR submit a record of vaccines. This proof can also be faxed directly to our office at 419-534-5384.

### 4. Save the Date: Green Bear Day!

Wednesday, August 9 8:00am-3:00pm



Previously known as Schedule Pick Up Day, Green Bear Day is our official day to kick off the school year. It should take each student less than an hour to get through each station. On Wednesday, August 9 students are to enter through the Arrowhead doors near the flagpole and report directly to the main gym. In order to receive their official course schedule and locker assignments, all current and outstanding fees must be paid (please pay online or in the office before you arrive).

On this day, students will also take their school photos, have the opportunity to turn in vaccination records, and connect with tech people if there are any computer issues.

## 5. Class of 2024 Seniors: Important Information

### College Bootcamp (different from the essay workshop):

Mrs. Nagy will hold College Application Bootcamps the week before school starts in August. Seniors must choose to attend one of the sessions offered:

Monday, August 7 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. 12:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.

Tuesday, August 8 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

Thursday, August 10 2:00 to 4:00 p.m.

During the bootcamp, students will update their SCOIR account, create their Common Application account, learn how to request their high school transcript, letters of recommendation, and other important information needed to complete their college applications.

Online registration will be available in early August. Students must bring a laptop computer to the bootcamp sessions.

### **College Essay Workshop:**

The Foundry plans to offer workshops this summer to help rising seniors begin their personal essay for their college applications. More information will be communicated by The Foundry. Students are encouraged to take advantage of this opportunity to get a head-start on this important aspect of the college application process.
