# RVQ & TAP

Flow and Process



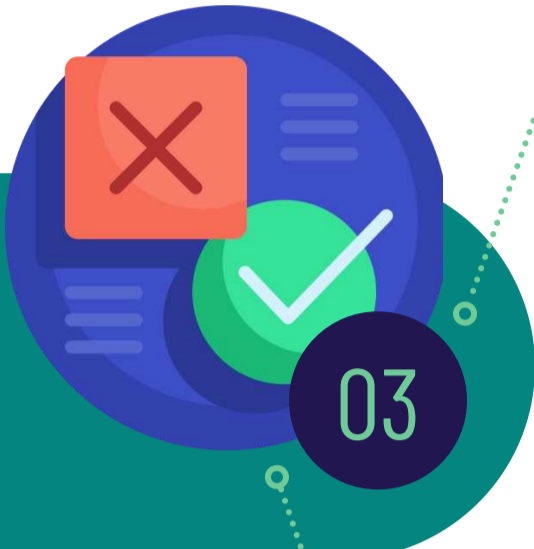
## Threat is Reported

Typically a student, parent or teacher reports a potential threat.

Counselor/Clinician  
**gathers information of threat to conduct the RVQ**



## Counselor/Clinician notify parent



Counselor/Clinician notify parent

## Administer RVQ

Administer RVQ by interviewing the student. Report findings of RVQ (low, medium or high) to the principal. If low, the principal can decide to monitor and manage student with RVQ safety plan.



## Principal receives RVQ report

If low, the principal can decide to intervene with the RVQ safety plan. If medium or high, the principal is recommended to call the campus threat assessment team together for a full threat evaluation.



## Principal calls for the School Threat Assessment Team

School-Based threat assessment team includes: counselors, assistant principals, principals, SROs and SPED teachers.



## Threat Assessment Team meets

The team analyzes RVQ data, gathers additional data, assess the student data and agrees on interventions and management of the student or situation.



## Intervene and Monitor Student

The Threat Assessment Team recommends interventions, disciplinary actions and/or monitoring plan.



## Review Plan if needed

If the plan needs to be reassessed the Threat Assessment Team can reassemble to review and amend the interventions and monitoring plan.

## Conclusion

The RVQ is a tool used to screen students as low, medium or high. Students screened as medium or high should be reported to the principal. The principal will have discretion whether to call the school threat assessment team to conduct a full threat assessment. The threat assessment includes assessing and reporting individuals who make threats of violence or exhibit harmful, threatening, or violent behavior in accordance with district policies and procedures; and gathering and analyzing data to determine the level of risk and appropriate intervention (FFB legal; Dallas ISD)
